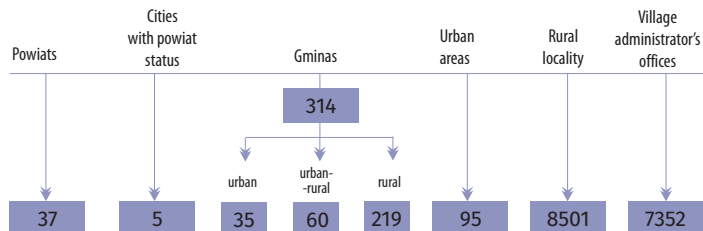
Location and administrative division

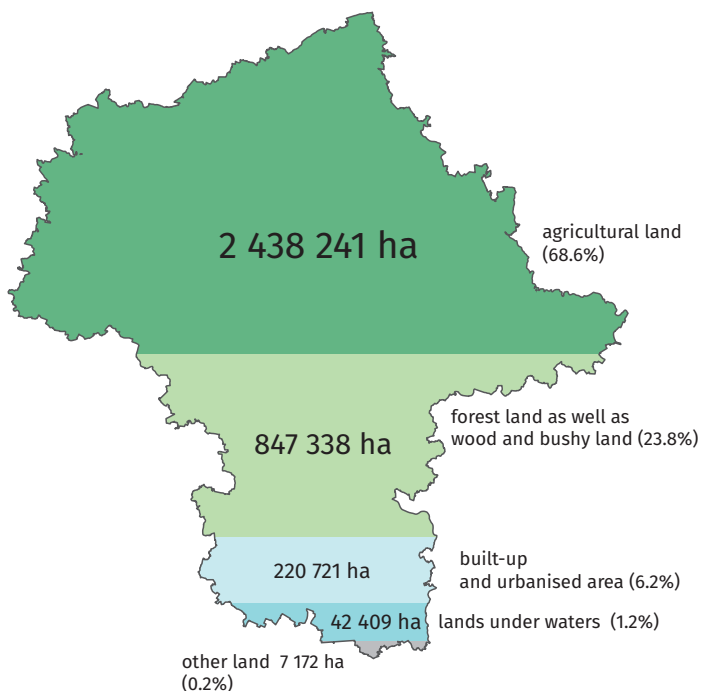

Geodesic area by directions of use

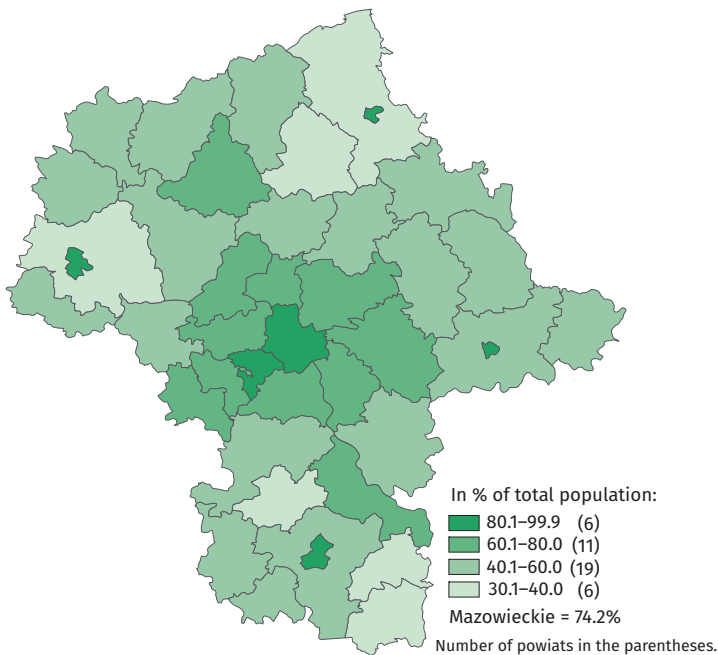

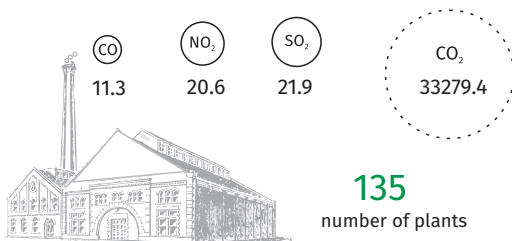

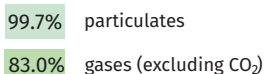

Emissions of main air pollutants (in thousand tonnes) from plants of significant nuisance to air quality in 2022



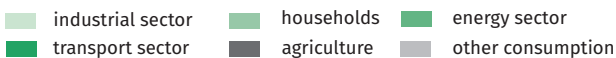
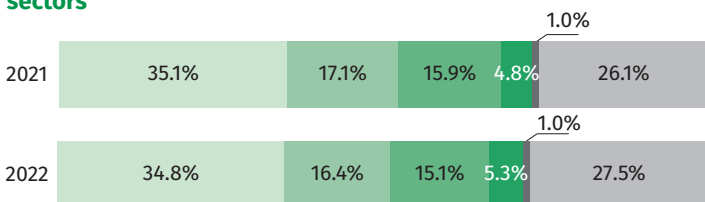
Pollutants retained in % of pollutants produced in 2022



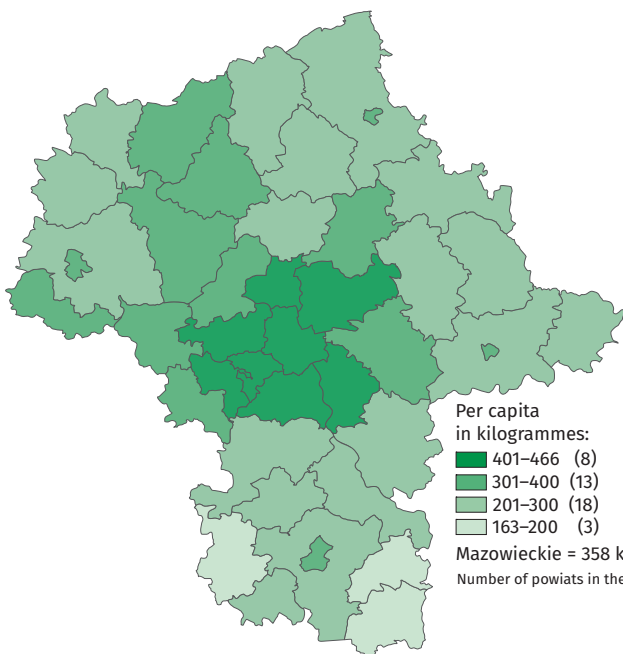

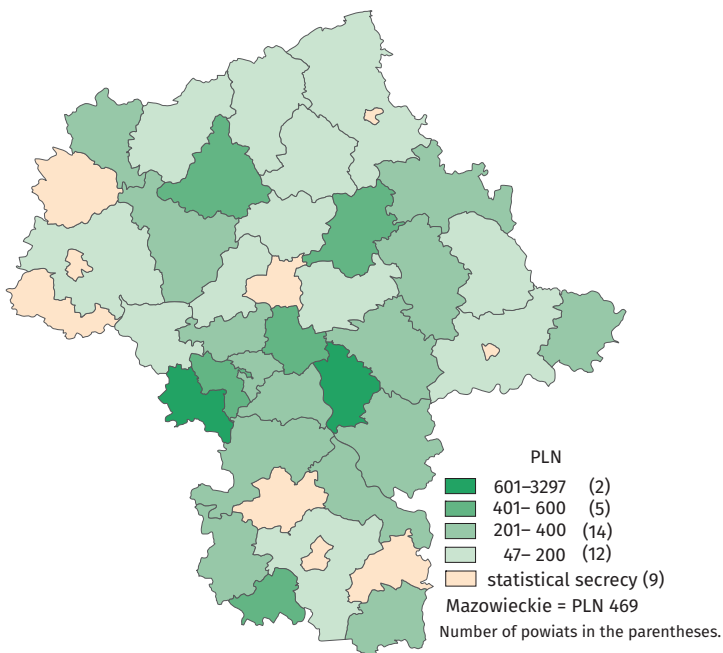
Structure of electricity consumption by economic sectors



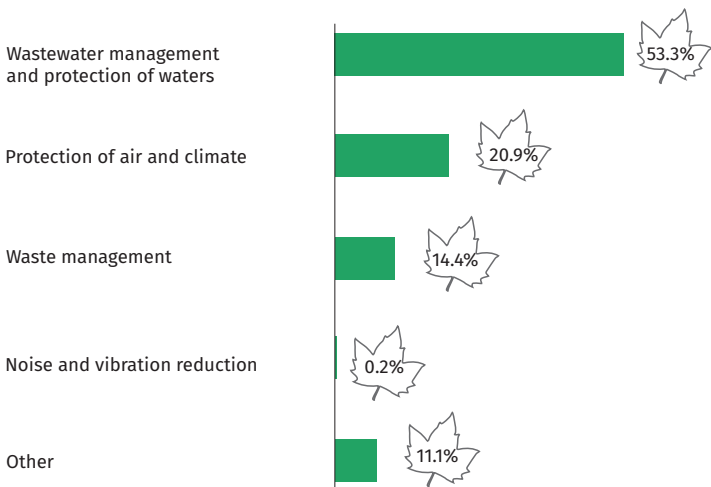

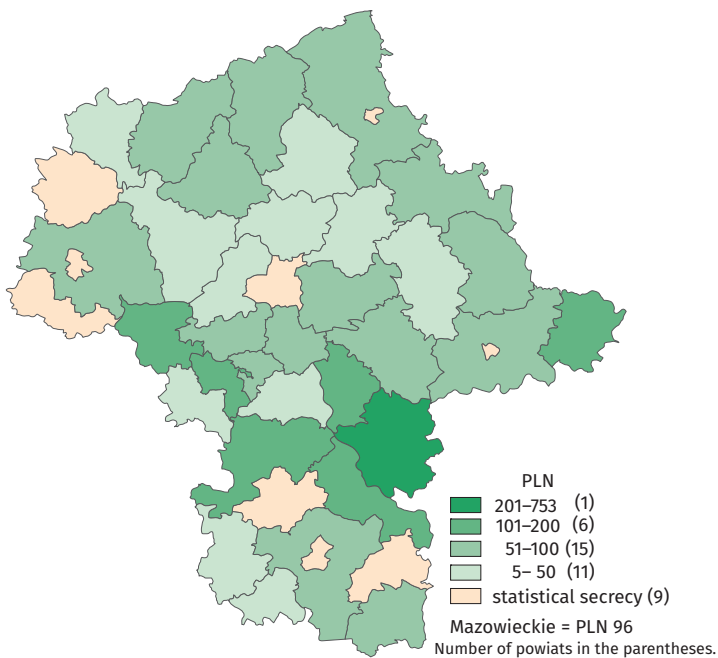
Outlays on fixed assets on environmental protection per capita in 2022



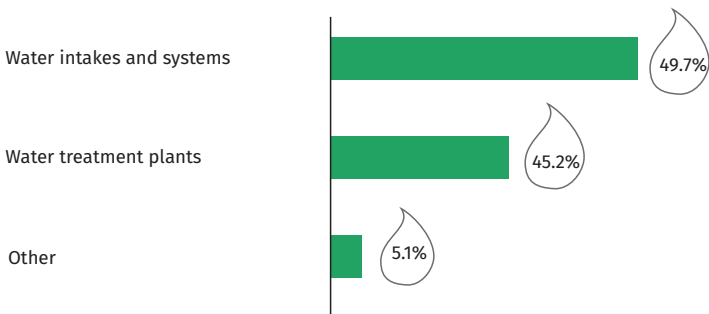
Structure of outlays on fixed assets on environmental protection in 2022



Outlays on fixed assets in water management per capita in 2022



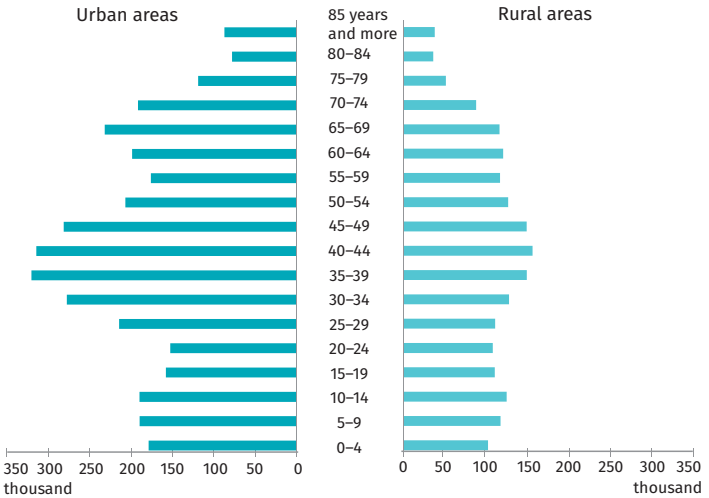
Structure of outlays on fixed assets in water management in 2022

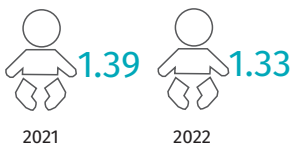

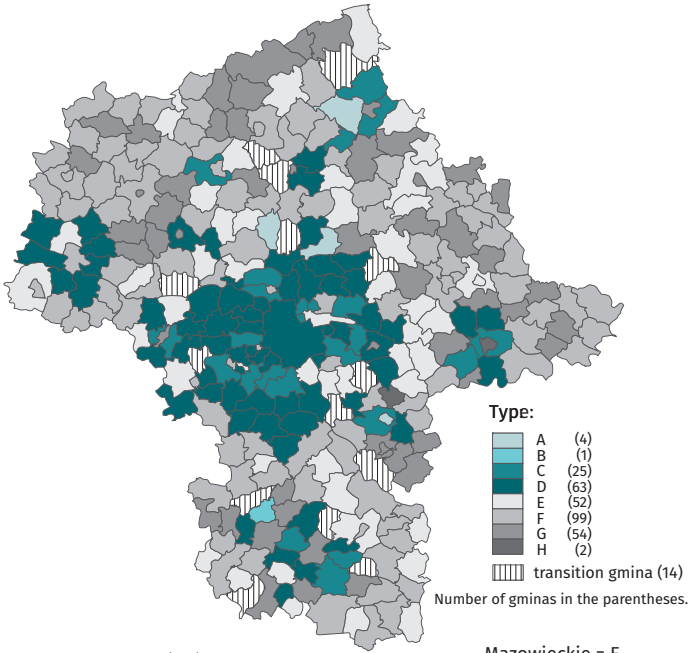

Types of population development of gminas by the Webb's method in 2022

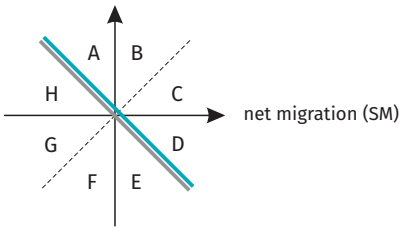

Internal and international migration of population for permanent residence by age groups in 2022



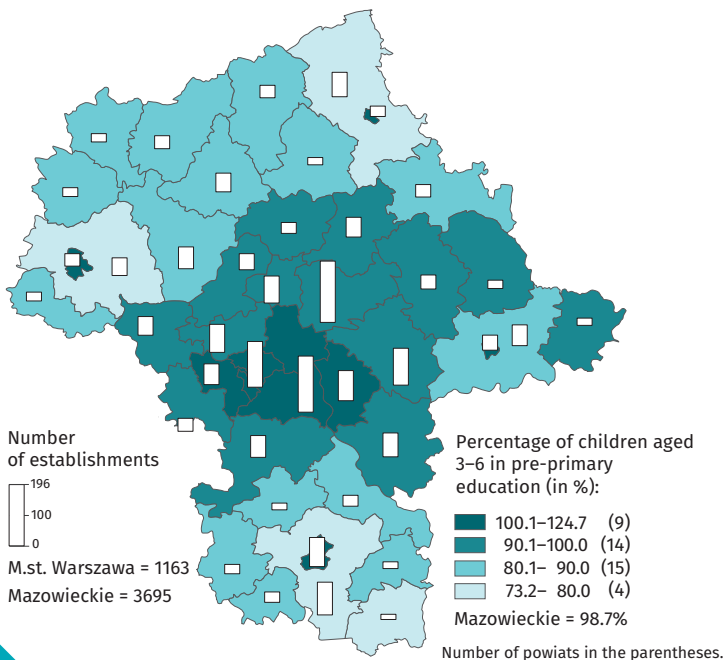
Internal migration of population for permanent residence by current and previous voivodship of residence in 2022

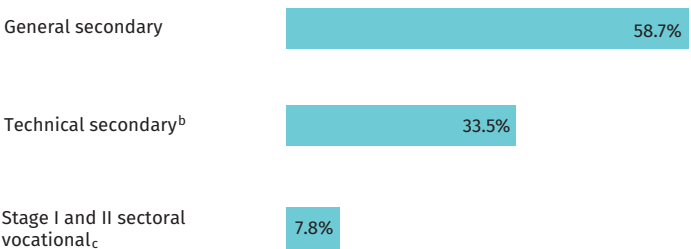

Structure of post-primary students^a in the school year 2022/23 by school type



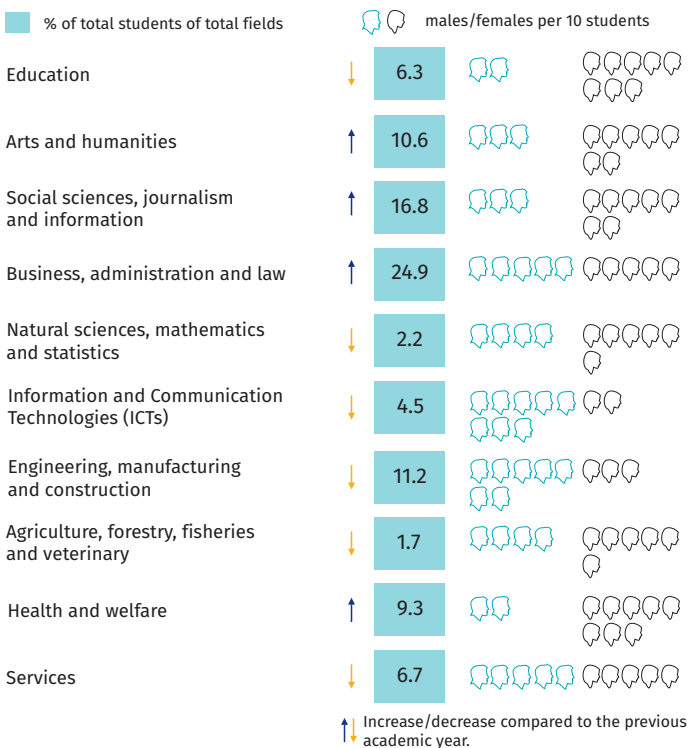

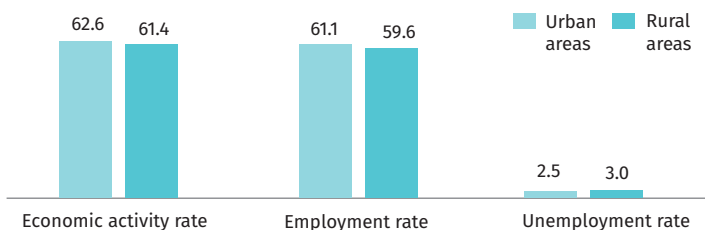

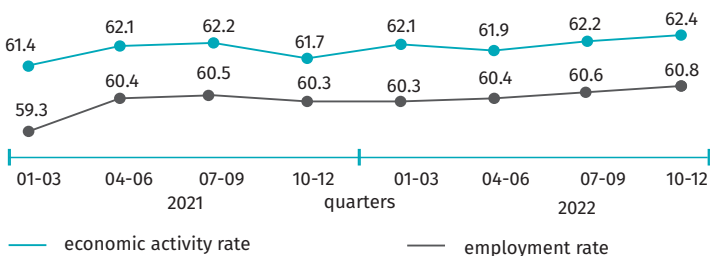

Economic activity rate and employment rate (in %)



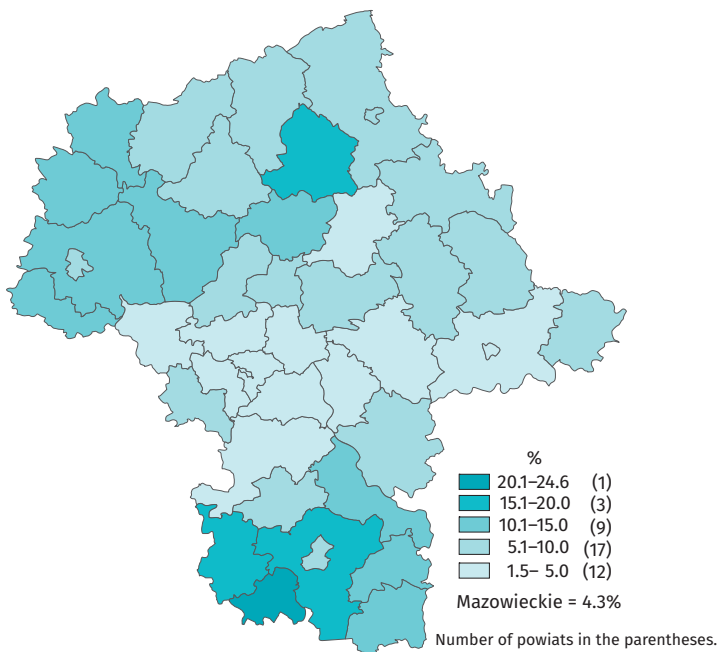

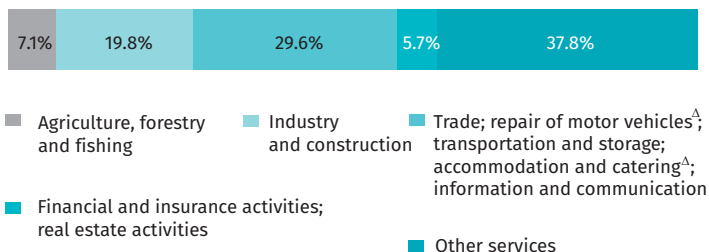
Registered unemployment rate in 2022

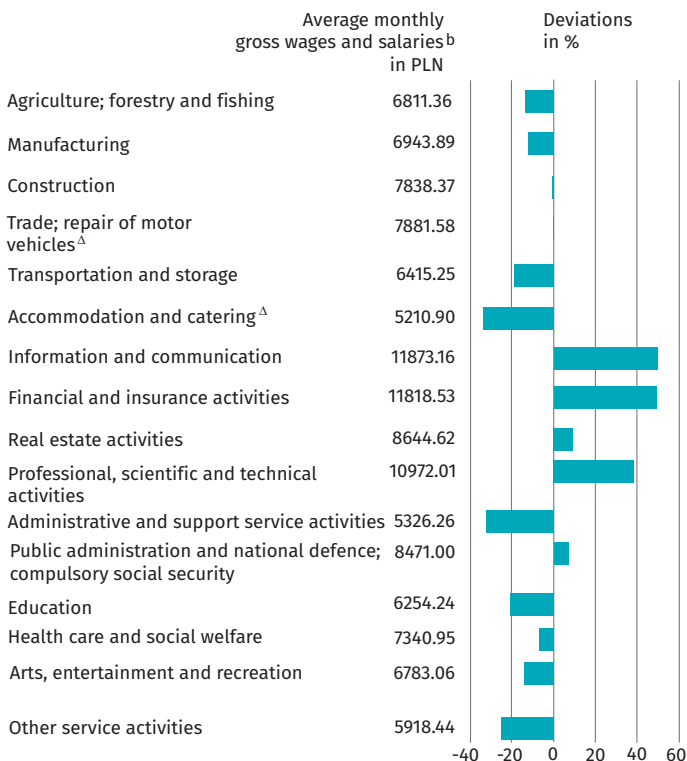

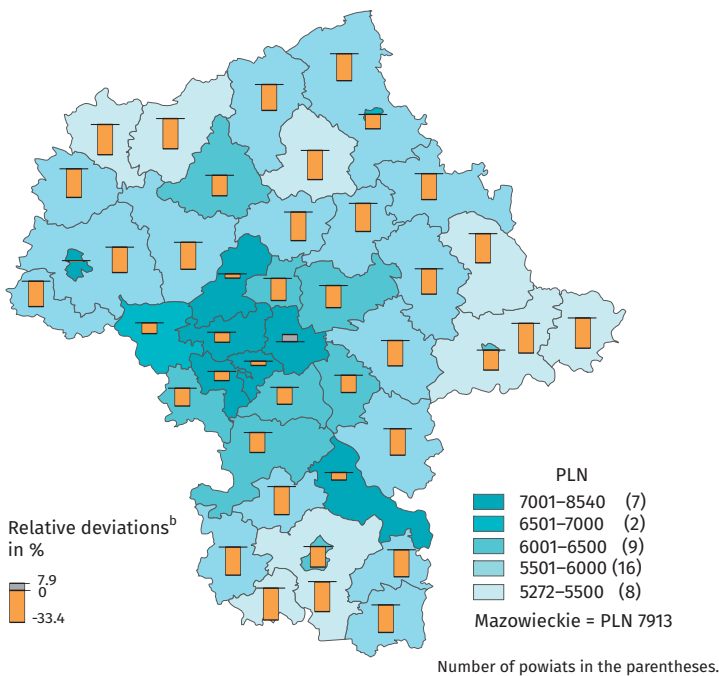
Relative deviations of average monthly gross wages and salaries from the average in the national economy of the Voivodship by selected sections in 2022

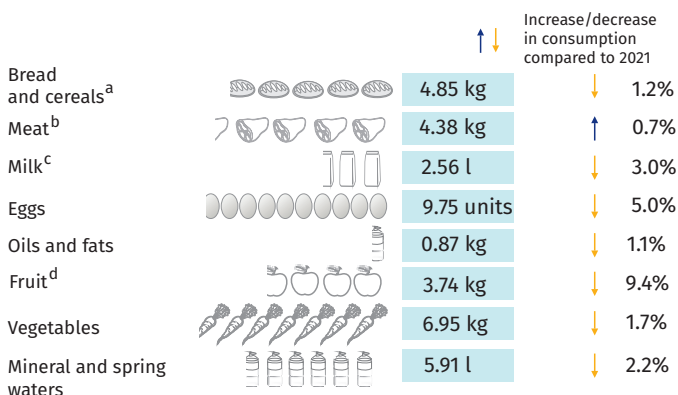

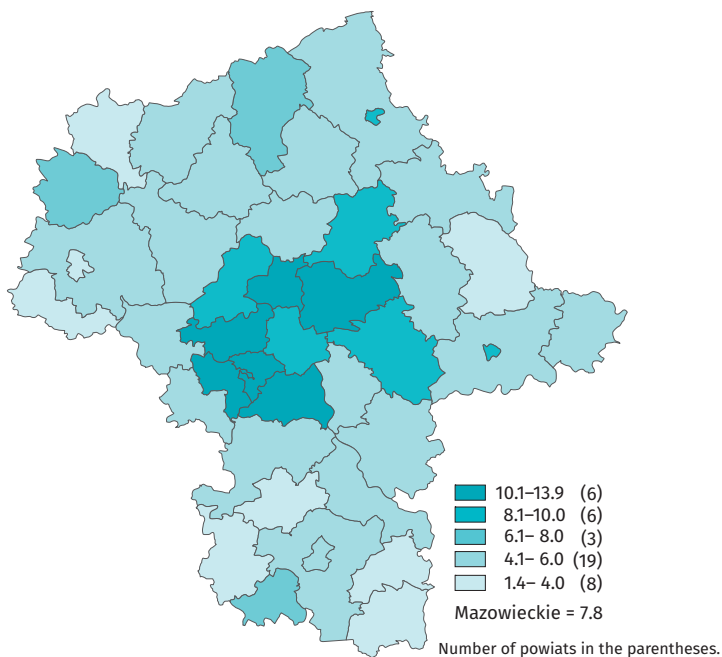

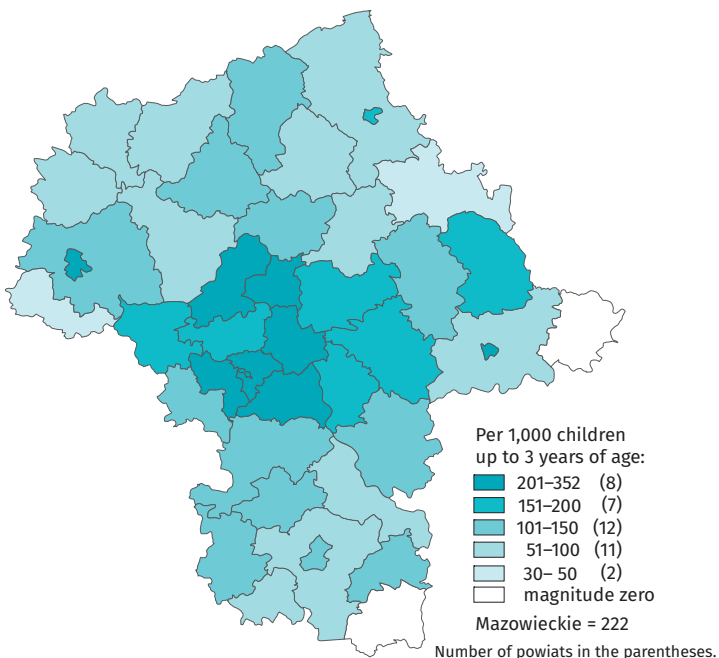

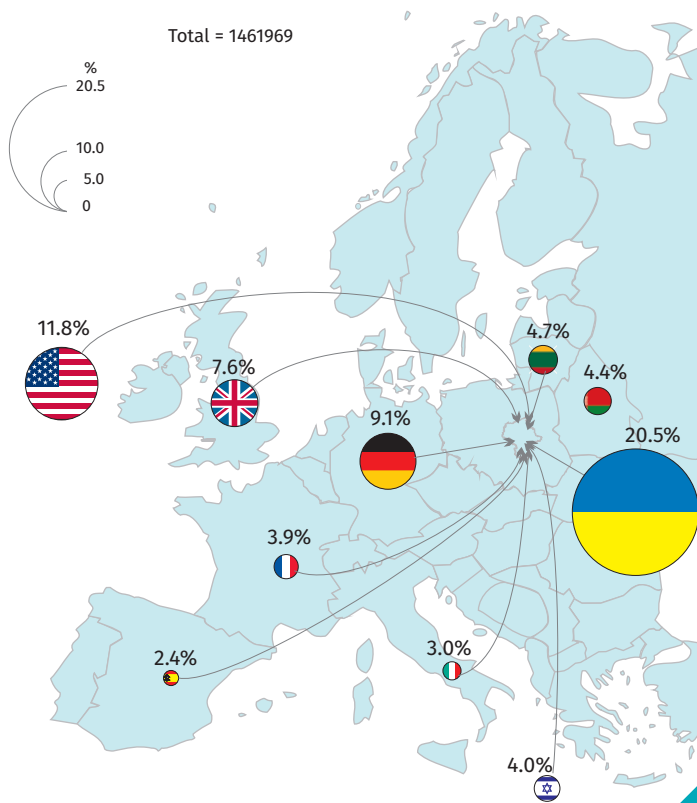

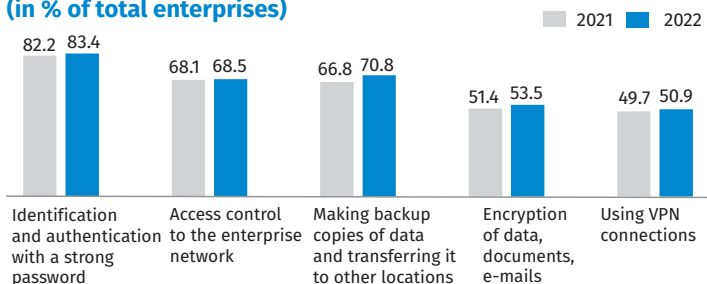
Foreign tourists in tourist accommodation establishments by selected countries in 2022



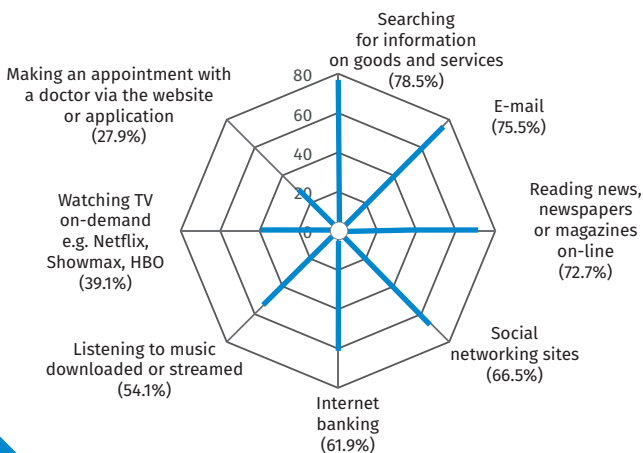

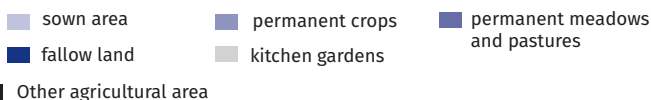

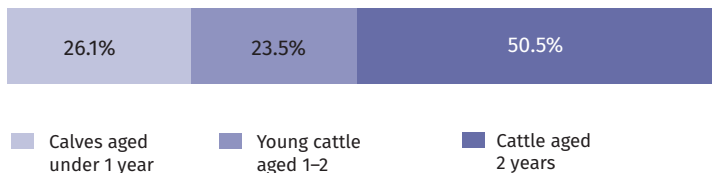

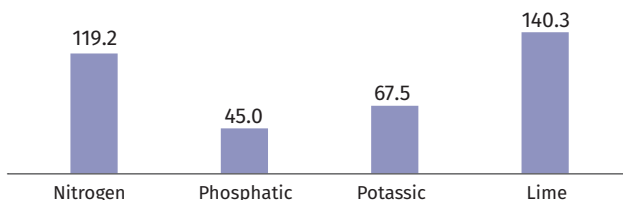


Structure of pigs by production and utility groups in 2022

Consumption of mineral and lime fertilisers in thousand tonnes in terms of pure ingredient^a in 2020



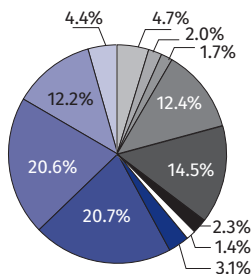

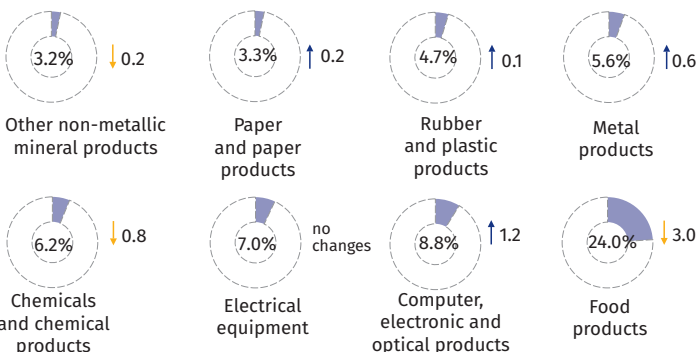

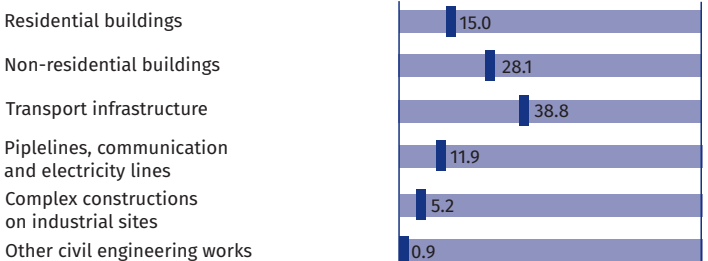
Sold production of manufacturing^a by selected divisions (in % of the total) in 2022

Structure of construction and assembly production^{ab} by type of construction in 2022



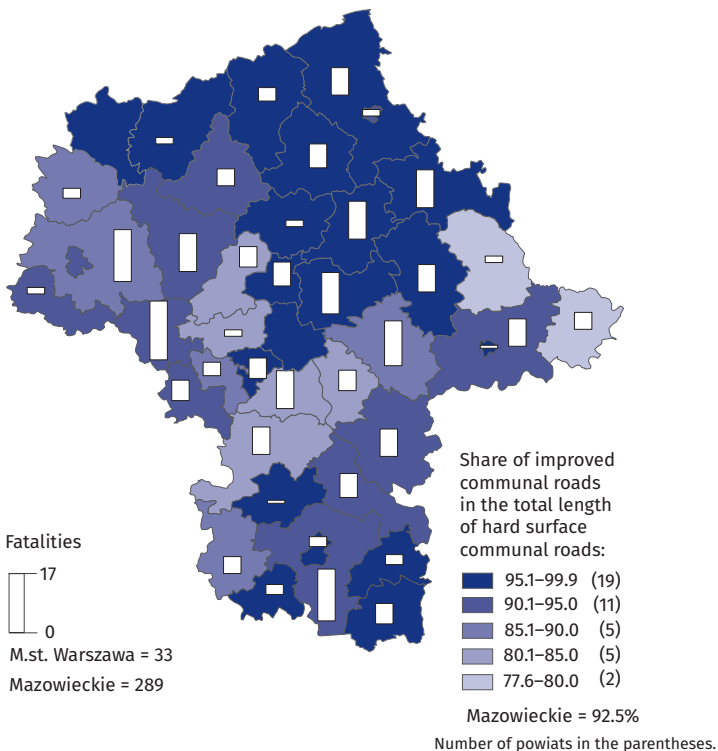

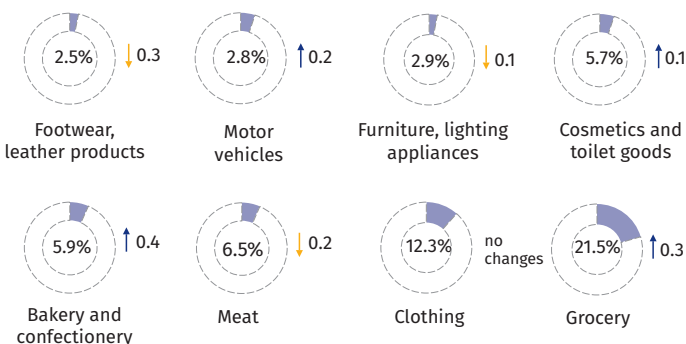

Structure of retail sale of goods by groups^a in 2022

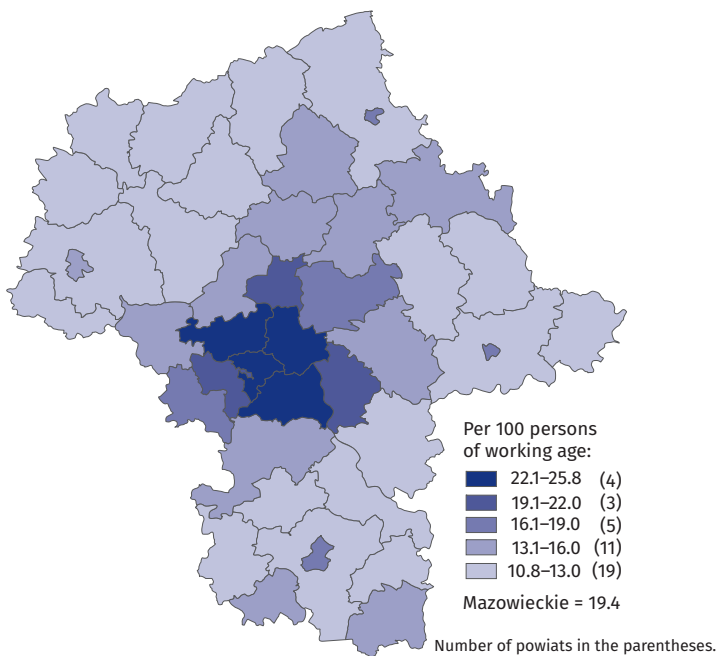

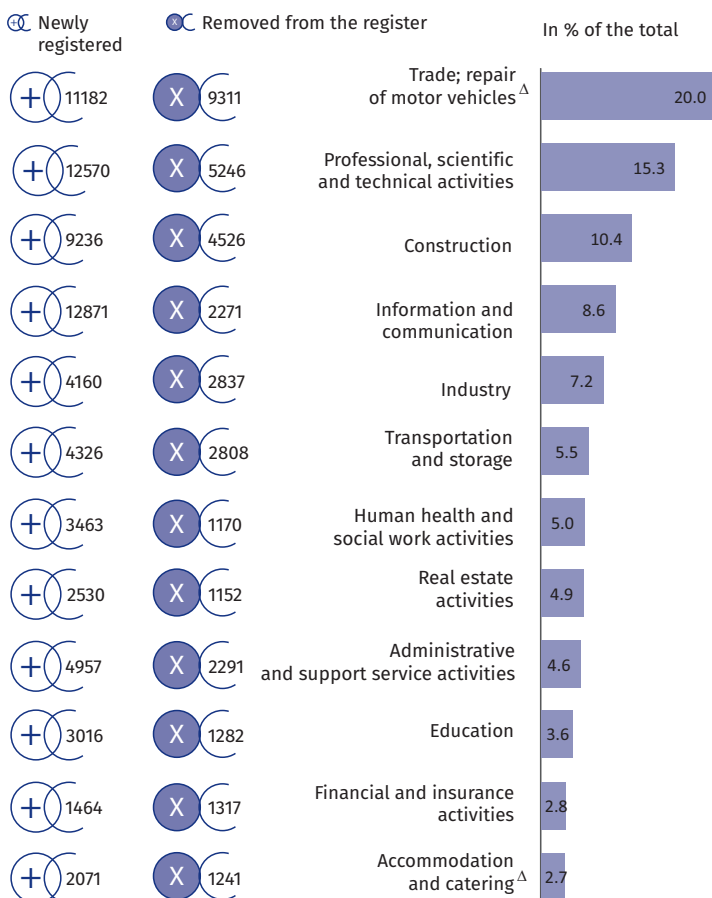

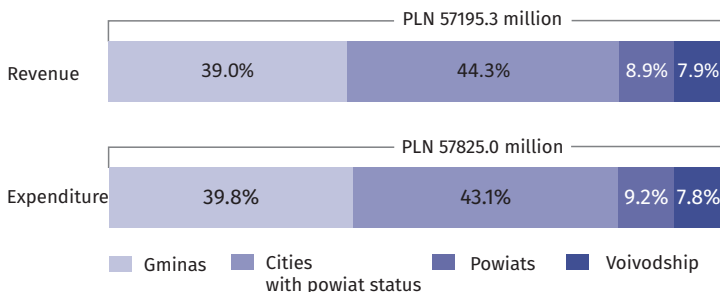

Revenue and expenditure of local government units in 2022

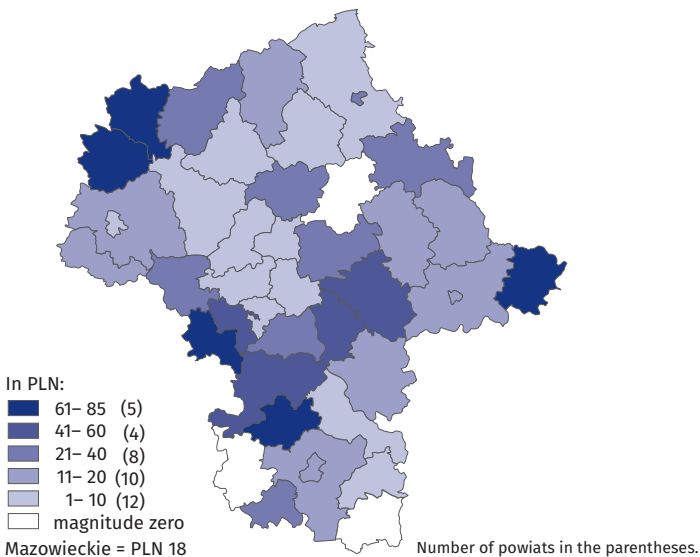


Share of revenue and expenditure of local government units budgets in the total by selected division in 2022

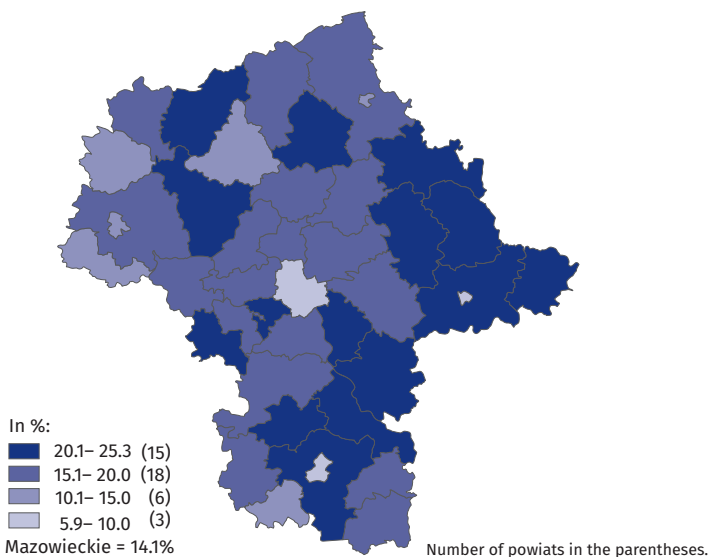

Gmina and powiat funds from the EU for financing programmes and projects per capita in 2022



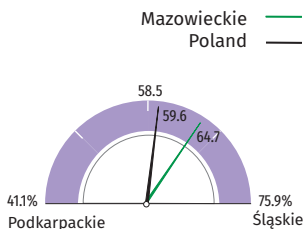
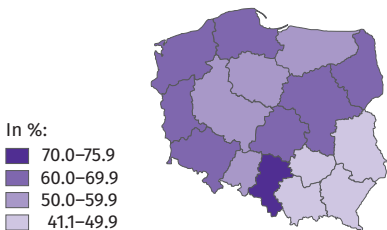
Share of investment expenditure of gminas and powiats in total expenditure in 2022



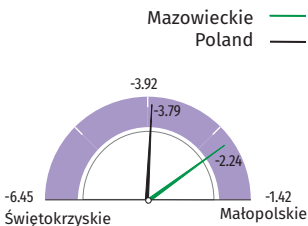
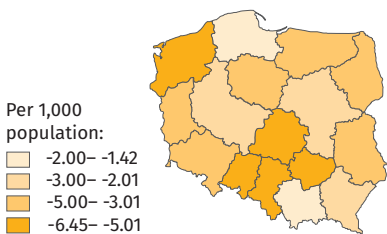

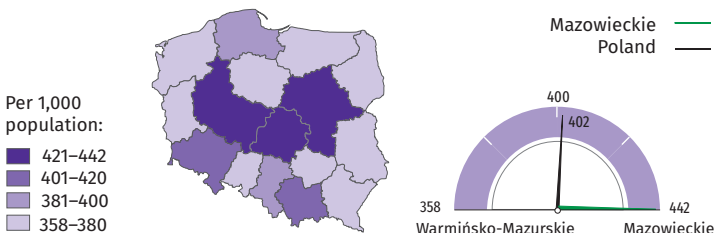
Net migration for permanent stay in 2022

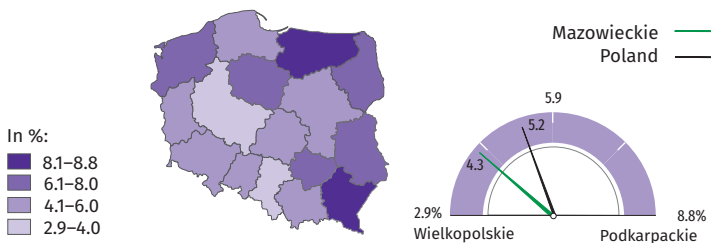

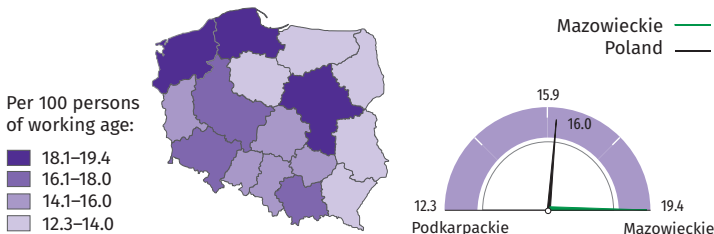
Registered unemployment rate in 2022

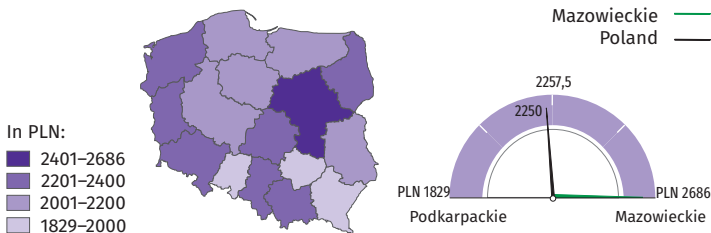

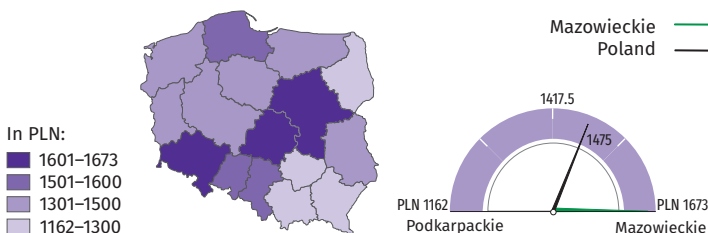

Average monthly available income per capita in households in 2022

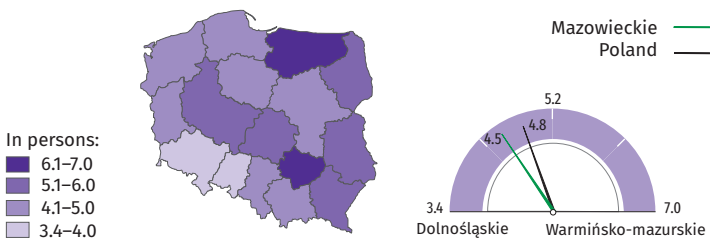


Average monthly expenditure per capita in households in 2022
