LABOUR MARKET

Average employment in Warsaw in enterprises sector in January 2015 amounted to 966.4 thousand people and was lower by 3.2 thousand people, i.e. 0.3% than in December 2014, and by 11.9 thousand people, i.e. 1.2% higher compared with January 2014.

At the end of January 2015 the number of **registered unemployed persons** equated to 50006 and was higher by 1166 persons, i.e. 2.4% than at the end of December 2014 and by 6003 persons, i.e. 10.7% lower than during the similar period of the year 2014.

The number of **unemployed women** amounted to 24040 which constituted 48.1% of all unemployed residents (in the previous month 48.2% and in the previous year 47.9%).

The registered unemployment rate equaled 4.4% (4.3% in December 2014, and 4.9% in January 2014).

TRADE

Retail sales in trade and non-trade enterprises in January 2015 (in current prices) was lower by 31.1% than in December 2014 and lower by 3.8% compared with January 2014.

Wholesale in trade enterprises in January 2015 (in current prices) decreased by 12.5% as compared with the previous month and increased by 6.0% as compared with January 2014; in wholesale enterprises it was lower by 14.6% and higher by 6.1% respectively.

INDUSTRY AND CONSTRUCTION

Sold production of industry in January 2015 amounted to (in current prices) 9483.8 million zł (2253.7 million EUR¹) and was lower by 6.3% (in constant prices) compared with January 2014.

Sold production of construction in January 2015 stood at (in current prices) 1524.9 million zł (362.4 million EUR¹) and was by 51.2% lower than in December 2014, and by 14.0% higher than over the same period of the previous year.

WAGES AND SALARIES

Average monthly gross wages and salaries in enterprise sector in January 2015 amounted to 5135.10 zł (1220.3 EUR¹) and were 4.6% lower than in December 2014, and 2.8% higher than in the similar period of 2014.

HOUSING CONSTRUCTION

According to preliminary data, 1435 dwellings were completed in Warsaw in January 2015 (4.9% more than in January 2014).

In January 2015 construction of 750 dwellings was initiated (42.7% less than during the similar period of 2014).

POPULATION OF WARSAW

At the end of September 2014 the capital city had 1 732 707 inhabitants. In comparison with the analogous period of the previous year the population increased by 0.7%. The highest increase of the population was registered in Wilanów (by 9.3%) and Białołęka (by 4.3%) and the lowest – in Ochota (by 0.2%) and Targówek (by 0.1%). In Warsaw population density was 3 350 persons per km².

The femininity ratio (number of women per 100 men) was 118; women were 54.1% of the population.

In the third quarter of 2014 in the capital city there were 5388 live births, which was by 7.0% more than in the analogous period of the previous year. Birth rate per 1 000 population was 12.45 which was 0.74 points higher than the year before.

In the discussed period 4 315 persons (including 18 infants) died in Warsaw. Death rate per 1 000 population stood at 9.97, compared to 10.39 in the previous year.

Infant death rate (per 1 000 live births) was 3.34 and was 0.36 points higher than a year earlier. Natural increase was positive and stood at 2.48‰.

In the third quarter of 2014 in Warsaw 3 283 marriages were contracted, 14 more than a year before. Marriage rate, which is the number of marriages per 1 000 population, was 7.59‰, by 0.01 points lower than in the analogous period of the previous year.

Net migration (internal and international, for permanent residence) in the third quarter of 2014 was positive and amounted to 2 515 persons, of which plus 11 accounted for international migration.
