#### LABOUR MARKET

**Average employment** in Warsaw in enterprises sector in May 2015 amounted to 960.5 thousand people and was higher by 0.2 thousand people than in April 2015, and by 3.8 thousand people, i.e. 0.4% higher compared with May 2014.

At the end of May 2015 the number of **registered unemployed persons** equated to 46110 and was lower by 1191 persons, i.e. 2.5% than at the end of April 2015 and by 7070 persons, i.e. 13.3 lower than during the similar period of the year 2014.

The number of **unemployed women** amounted to 21898 which constituted 47.5% of all unemployed residents (in the previous month 47.6% and in the previous year 47.3%).

**The registered unemployment rate** equaled 4.1% (4.2% in April 2015, and 4.7% in May 2014).

#### TRADE

**Retail sales** in trade and non-trade enterprises in May 2015 (in current prices) was by 2.7% higher than in April 2015 and was lower by 3.7% compared with May 2014.

**Wholesale** in trade enterprises in May 2015 (in current prices) decreased by 3.6% as compared with the previous month and increased by 2.1% as compared with May 2014; in wholesale enterprises it was lower by 3.8% and higher by 1.7% respectively.

#### INDUSTRY AND CONSTRUCTION

**Sold production of industry** in May 2015 amounted to (in current prices) 8164.5 million zł (1976.8 million EUR<sup>1</sup>) and was lower by 3.6% (in constant prices) compared with May 2014.

In January to May 2015 sold production of industry reached 44858.9 mln zł (10861.5 million EUR<sup>1</sup>) (in current prices) and was (in constant prices) lower by 5.2% compared with the same period of 2014.

**Sold production of construction** in May 2015 stood at (in current prices) 2835.6 million zł (686.6 million EUR<sup>1</sup>) and was by 14.5% lower than in April 2015, and by 0.8% higher than over the same period of the previous year.

In January-May 2015 sold production of industry reached 12232.2 mln zł (2961.7 million EUR<sup>1</sup>), i.e. by 2.7% higher than over the same period of 2014.

#### WAGES AND SALARIES

**Average monthly gross wages and salaries** in enterprise sector in May 2015 amounted to 5243.62 zł (1269.6 EUR<sup>1</sup>) and were 3.2% lower than in April 2015, and 2.0% higher than in the similar period of 2014.

#### HOUSING CONSTRUCTION

According to preliminary data, 4170 dwellings were completed in Warsaw in January-May 2015 (28.6% less than in the same period of 2014).

In January-May 2015 construction of 7203 dwellings was initiated (9.8% more than during the similar period of 2014).

#### Blood donation

in Poland relies on voluntary unpaid donors. A person who donated blood free of charge

and was registered in a public blood donor centre is given a title of "Honourable Blood Donor". Blood is drawn in Regional Blood Donation Centres and in Local Departments.

- There is one regional centre and 3 local departments in the capital city where 40.3 thousand persons donated blood, which represented 55.9% of blood donors in the voivodship.
- Compared with 2013, the number of blood donors increased by 1354 persons (3.5%), and compared with 2012 by 442 persons (1.9%).
- There were 233 blood donors per 10 thousand population in 2014, i.e. 6 more than in a previous year, and 2 more than in 2012.
- During 2014, there were 68.0 thousand units of blood drawn, i.e. approximately 30.6 thousand litres (51.6% of blood drawn in the voivodship). It was a material for 66.7 thousand units of freshly frozen plasma (50.4% of all plasma produced in the voivodship).
- Compared with 2013 the number of blood donations increased by 4.1 thousand (by 6.2%).

Warsaw is the national hub of specialist health care services, provided by such medical centres as e.g. Institute of Haematology and Transfusion Medicine, Maria Skłodowska-Curie Memorial Cancer Centre and Institute of Oncology, Institute of Tuberculosis and Lung Diseases, Children's Memorial Health Institute.

Health care infrastructure includes establishments of inpatient (i.e. hospitals) and outpatient health care. In 2014 within the outpatient health care there were 1106 outpatient health care institutions (together with primary care practices, outpatient clinics and departments, infirmaries, diagnostic facilities and medical diagnostic laboratories). In comparison to 2013, their number increased by 29. The largest numbers of outpatient health care institutions are located in central districts with large population such as Śródmieście and Mokotów (177 and 166, respectively), and the lowest numbers – in peripheral less populous districts, such as Rembertów, Wesoła and Włochy (6, 13, 16 respectively). Outpatient health care services financed from public funds are provided, apart from outpatient health care departments, by primary care practices. In 2014 there were 29 of them in Warsaw (by 2 more than in the preceding year).

In total, in outpatient health care 20479.4 thousand consultations were provided (2.9% more than in 2013), of which doctor's consultations consisted 87.5%, and dentist's consultations – 12.5% (as regards doctor's - 2.8% and dentist's - 3.3% more than in the preceding year). In 2014 primary health care doctors and family doctors provided together 5358.2 thousand consultations, whereas specialist doctors – 12563.7 thousand. Regardless the district where consultations were provided, women used doctor's and dentist's services more often than men (60.1% of all consultations provided). People over 65 years of age were frequent visitors – receiving 25.8% of consultations. A relatively low proportion of persons receiving consultations in health care establishments were children and youth up to 18 years old – 18.1%.

Inhabitants of the capital city could use 622 generally available pharmacies (by 18 more than a year before), in which 1748 pharmacists worked, i.e. 1.5% more than in 2013.
