LABOUR MARKET

Average employment in Warsaw in enterprises sector in June 2015 amounted to 961.5 thousand people and was by 0.9 thousand people, i.e. 0.1% higher than in May 2015, and by 2.4 thousand people, i.e. 0.2% higher compared with June 2014.

At the end of June 2015 the number of **registered unemployed persons** equated to 44723 and was lower by 1387 persons, i.e. 3.0% than at the end of May 2015 and by 7449 persons, i.e. 14.3 lower than during the similar period of the year 2014.

The number of **unemployed women** amounted to 21393 which constituted 47.8% of all unemployed residents (in the previous month 47.5% and in the previous year 47.7%).

The registered unemployment rate equaled 3.9% (4.1% in May 2015, and 4.6% in June 2014).

TRADE

Retail sales in trade and non-trade enterprises in June 2015 (in current prices) was by 0.3% lower than in May 2015 and by 2.4% lower compared with June 2014.

Wholesale in trade enterprises in June 2015 (in current prices) increased by 6.8% as compared with the previous month and by 7.0% as compared with June 2014; in wholesale enterprises it was higher by 4.6% and 6.5% respectively.

INDUSTRY AND CONSTRUCTION

Sold production of industry in June 2015 amounted to (in current prices) 8333.6 million zł (1986.8 million EUR¹) and was lower by 2.5% (in constant prices) compared with June 2014.

In January to June 2015 sold production of industry reached 53166.7 mln zł (12675.6 million EUR¹) (in current prices) and was (in constant prices) lower by 5.0% compared with the same period of 2014.

Sold production of construction in June 2015 stood at (in current prices) 2889.7 million zł (688.9 million EUR¹) and was by 1.9% higher than in May 2015, and by 2.9% higher than over the same period of the previous year.

In January-June 2015 sold production of industry reached 15404.3 mln zł (3672.6 million EUR¹), i.e. by 2.8% higher than over the same period of 2014.

WAGES AND SALARIES

Average monthly gross wages and salaries in enterprise sector in June 2015 amounted to 5216.07 zł (1243.6 EUR¹) and were 0.5% lower than in May 2015, and 2.6% higher than in the similar period of 2014.

HOUSING CONSTRUCTION

According to preliminary data, 5413 dwellings were completed in Warsaw in January-June 2015 (22.3% less than in the same period of 2014).

In January-June 2015 construction of 8178 dwellings was initiated (1.1% more than during the similar period of 2014).

June 24th POLICE DAY

State Police were established by the Law of the Second Polish Republic on 24th June 1919. We commemorate this event by celebrating June 24th as Police Day.

- According to the data of Warsaw Capital City Police Headquarters in January to June 2015 there were 25.5 thousand ascertained crimes in completed preparatory proceedings in the capital city.
- Compared to the same period of 2014, the number of ascertained crimes increased by 3.2%.
- In the structure of crimes according to their character the criminal offences prevailed representing 76.5% of all ascertained crimes.
- In the Capital City of Warsaw crimes against economy made up 17.0%.
- Rates of detectability of delinquents in ascertained crimes in January to June 2015 stood at 47.3%.

The Police activities concerning public safety and order are supported by the Municipal Police.

- In the second quarter of 2015 officials of the Municipal Police received 119.2 thousand notifications, of these 67.8% from citizens.
- Majority of notifications concerned order in road traffic (42.1%) as well as safety and order in public places (38.3%).

MOST RECENT DATA ON PUBLIC SAFETY

In 2014, according to the data of Warsaw Capital City Police Headquarters, 50.7 thousand ascertained crimes were registered in the completed preparatory proceedings. Criminal offences constituted 82.8% of all ascertained crimes, crimes against economy – 10.9%, and road crimes – 4.9%.

In comparison with 2013, there was a 9.0% decrease in the number of ascertained crimes. The number of road crimes and criminal offences diminished by 30.1% and 5.4%, respectively, whereas the number of crimes against economy increased by 4.5%.

The rate of detection of delinquents decreased from 45.0% in 2013 to 41.1% in 2014. The rate of detection of criminal offenders diminished by 9.4 percentage points, of offenders who committed crimes against economy – by 5.1 percentage points and of road offenders – by 0.6 percentage points.

Public order in Warsaw area is protected not only by the Police, but also by the Municipal Police, which in 2014 received 439.9 thousand notifications (i.e. 0.5% less than in 2013), of which 66.0% were reported by the inhabitants of the capital city. As in the earlier years, the largest number of notifications concerned public order in road traffic (42.0% of all notifications) and illegal sale of controlled substances and threats to health (20.6%). In 2014 the Municipal Police intervened 598.0 thousand times (i.e. by 8.5% less than in the preceding year).

Another formation which deals with public safety in Warsaw is State Fire Service that, apart from providing firefighting services, predominantly fights against negative consequences of natural disasters and other local threats, including road accidents. According to the preliminary data of the Municipal Headquarters of the State Fire Service in the capital city of Warsaw, 4257 fires were recorded in 2014 (i.e. by 8.0% more than in 2012). Out of the total number of fires 98.7% were classified as small. In the discussed period the fire service registered 6285 local threats (i.e. by 11.4% more than in 2013) and 2314 false alarms (i.e. by 24.3% more than a year earlier).
