LABOUR MARKET

Average employment in Warsaw in enterprise sector in November 2015 amounted to 971.3 thousand people and was by 5.6 thousand people, i.e. 0.6% higher than in October 2015, and by 2.6 thousand people, i.e. 0.3% higher compared with November 2014.

At the end of November 2015 the number of **registered unemployed persons** equated to 40912 and was lower by 860 persons, i.e. 2.1% than at the end of October 2015 and by 9181 persons, i.e. 18.3% lower than during the similar period of the year 2014.

The number of **unemployed women** amounted to 19811 which constituted 48.4% of all unemployed residents (in the previous month 48.5% and in the previous year 48.4%).

The registered unemployment rate equaled 3.5% (3.6% in October 2015, and 4.4% in November 2014).

TRADE

Retail sales in trade and non-trade enterprises in November 2015 (in current prices) was by 5.3% lower than in October 2015 and by 6.6% lower compared with November 2014.

Wholesale in trade enterprises in November 2015 (in current prices) increased by 0.9% as compared with the previous month and by 15.6% as compared with November 2014; in wholesale enterprises it was lower by 0.2% and higher by 13.0%.

INDUSTRY AND CONSTRUCTION

Sold production of industry in November 2015 amounted to (in current prices) 9861.6 mln zl (2312.8 mln EUR¹) and was higher by 5.1% (in constant prices) compared with November 2014

In January to November 2015 sold production of industry reached 98792.3 mln zl (23169.5 mln EUR¹) (in current prices) and was (in constant prices) lower by 1.6% compared with the same period of 2014.

Sold production of construction in November 2015 stood at (in current prices) 3318.9 mln zl (778.4 mln EUR¹) and compared with October 2015 remained on the same level, and compared with the same period of the previous year it was by 10.8% higher.

In January-November 2015 sold production of construction reached 33601.3 mln zl (7880.4 mln EUR¹), i.e. by 0.6% lower than over the same period of 2014.

WAGES AND SALARIES

Average monthly gross wages and salaries in enterprise sector in November 2015 amounted to 5304.33 zl (1244.0 EUR¹) and were 2.6% lower than in October 2015, and 3.5% higher than in the similar period of 2014.

HOUSING CONSTRUCTION

According to preliminary data, 11954 dwellings were completed in Warsaw in January-November 2015 (11.4% less than in the same period of 2014).

In January-November 2015 construction of 17703 dwellings was initiated (4.0% more than during the similar period of 2014).

I ABOUR MARKET

Warsaw is the workplace not only for the inhabitants of the city but also for the people from all over Mazowieckie voivodship. In 2014 among all entities of the national economy with headquarters in Mazowieckie voivodship, over a half were situated in the capital city, which had an impact on the number of workplaces.

At the end of December 2014 the number of employed persons in Warsaw was 833.5 thous. (by 3.1% higher than in 2013). Persons employed in the private sector made up 64.8% of the total employed persons. The number of persons employed in the public sector amounted to 293.2 thous. The number of employed women exceeded that of men, their share was 53.4%.

At the end of December 2014 in Warsaw the unemployment rate equaled 4.2% (by 0.6 p. p. lower than in the previous year) and was one of the lowest in the country. There were 48 840 registered unemployed persons and the number decreased by 10.9% in comparison with the same period of the preceding year. Among the unemployed, two age groups with the highest unemployment level stood out (25–34 years and 35–44 years). Almost every fourth unemployed person in Warsaw was between 25 and 34 years old. The people aged 35–44 constituted 24.4% of all unemployed people in Warsaw. Taking into account work seniority the largest groups among the unemployed were persons with up to 1 year of work experience, with 1–5 years and 10–20 years (respectively: 19.6%, 17.0% and 16.2%). With respect to education level, the largest group among the unemployed were persons with higher education (26.5%), lower secondary, primary and incomplete primary (24.5%) and post-secondary and vocational secondary (23.5%).

At the end of December 2014 the number of job offers was 2437, hence there were 20 unemployed persons per 1 job offer.
