LABOUR MARKET

Average employment in Warsaw in enterprise sector in January 2014 amounted to 954.5 thousand people and was by 0.2 thousand people higher than in December 2013 and by 12.4 thousand people, i.e. 1.3% higher than in January 2013.

At the end of January 2014 the number of **registered unemployed persons** was 56009 and was by 1167 persons, i.e. 2.1% higher than at the end of December 2013 and by 3780 persons, i.e. 7.2%, higher than during the similar period of the year 2013.

The number of **unemployed women** amounted to 26830 which constituted 47.9% of all unemployed residents (in the previous month 48.1% and in the previous year 48.3%).

The **registered unemployment rate** was 4.9% (4.8% in December 2013, and 4.6% in January 2013).

TRADE

Retail sales in trade and non-trade enterprises in January 2014 (in current prices) were 27.6% lower than in December 2013 and 4.4% higher than in January 2013.

Wholesale in trade enterprises in January 2014 (in current prices) was 14.3% lower than in December 2013, and 2.8% lower in comparison with January 2013 and in wholesale enterprises it was lower by 12.8% and 5.2%, respectively.

INDUSTRY AND CONSTRUCTION

Sold production of industry in January 2014 amounted to (in current prices) 9887.9 million zł (2366.9 million EUR¹) and was 12.4% higher (in constant prices) compared to January 2013.

Sold production of construction in January 2014 stood at (in current prices) 1337.8 million zł (320.2 million EUR¹) and was 53.4% lower than in December 2013, and 20.7% lower than in the same period of the previous year.

WAGES AND SALARIES

Average monthly gross wages and salaries in enterprise sector in January 2014 amounted to 4995.41 zł (1195.79 EUR¹) and were 4.4% lower than in December 2013, and 2.9% higher than in the similar period of 2013.

HOUSING CONSTRUCTION

According to preliminary data, 1319 dwellings were completed in Warsaw in January 2014 (9.3% less than in the similar period of 2013).

In January 2014 construction of 1310 dwellings was initiated (9.8% more than during the similar period of 2013).

POPULATION OF WARSAW

In the end of September 2013 the capital city had 1 721 248 inhabitants. In comparison with the analogous period of the previous year the population increased by 0.4%. The highest increase of the population was registered in Wilanów (by 8.5%) and the lowest – in Targówek and Wola (both by 0.1%). In Warsaw population density was 3 328 persons per km².

The femininity ratio (number of women per 100 men) was 118; women were 54.1% of the population.

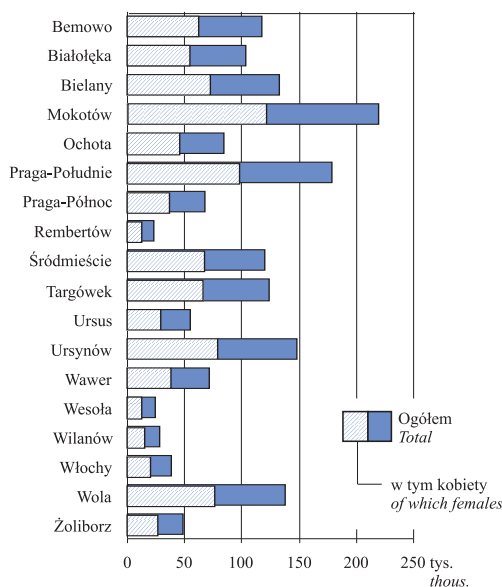
In the third quarter of 2013 in the capital city there were 5036 live births, which was by 1.5% more than in the analogous period of the previous year. Birth rate per 1 000 population was 11.71 which was 0.12 points higher than the year before.

In the discussed period 4 469 persons (including 15 infants) died. Death rate per 1 000 population stood at 10.39, compared to 10.03 in the previous year. The number of registered infant deaths was by 8 cases lower than a year before. Infant death rate (per 1 000 live births) was 2.98 and was 1.66 points lower than a year earlier. Natural increase was positive and stood at 1.32‰.

In the third quarter of 2013 in Warsaw 3 269 marriages were contracted, 67 less than a year before. Marriage rate was 7.60‰, by 0.19 points lower than in the analogous period of the previous year.

Net migration (internal and international, for permanent residence) in the discussed period was positive and amounted to 2 462 persons, of which plus 17 accounted for international migration.
