LABOUR MARKET

Average employment in Warsaw in enterprise sector in August 2016 amounted to 995.8 thousand people and was by 0.2 thousand people lower than in July 2016, and by 32.0 thousand people, i.e. 3.3% higher compared with August 2015.

At the end of August 2016 the number of **registered unemployed persons** equated to 36385 and was lower by 553 persons, i.e. 1.5% than at the end of July 2016 and by 7332 persons, i.e. 16.8% lower than during the similar period of the year 2015.

The number of **unemployed women** amounted to 18364 which constituted 50.5% of all unemployed residents (in the previous month 50.0% and in the previous year 48.9%).

The registered unemployment rate equaled 3.1% (in the previous month 3.1% and in the previous year 3.8%).

TRADE

Retail sales in trade and non-trade enterprises in August 2016 (in current prices) was by 0.7% lower than in July 2016 and by 5.1% higher compared with August 2015.

Wholesale in trade enterprises in August 2016 (in current prices) decreased by 2.3% as compared with the previous month and increased by 16.8% as compared with August 2015; in wholesale enterprises it was higher by 0.4% and by 13.3% respectively.

INDUSTRY AND CONSTRUCTION

Sold production of industry in August 2016 amounted to (in current prices) 8157.7 mln zł (1873.0 mln EUR¹) and was higher by 1.2% (in constant prices) compared with August 2015.

In January to August 2016 sold production of industry reached 68896.6 mln zł (15818.3 mln EUR¹) (in current prices) and was (in constant prices) higher by 2.7% compared with the same period of 2015.

Sold production of construction in August 2016 stood at (in current prices) 2890.4 mln zł (663.6 mln EUR¹) and compared with July 2016 decreased by 13.8%, and compared with the same period of the previous year it was by 6.9% lower.

In January–August 2016 sold production of construction reached 24802.2 mln zł (5694.5 mln EUR¹), i.e. by 10.7% higher than over the same period of 2015.

WAGES AND SALARIES

Average monthly gross wages and salaries in enterprise sector in August 2016 amounted to 5371.34 zł (1233.2 EUR¹) and were 1.1% lower than in July 2016, and 2.9% higher than in the similar period of 2015.

HOUSING CONSTRUCTION

According to preliminary data, 12545 dwellings were completed in Warsaw in January–August 2016 (69.8% more than in the same period of 2015).

In January–August 2016 construction of 13934 dwellings was initiated (18.9% more than during the similar period of 2015).

Actions taken on this day aim at giving motorists and commuters an idea of their locality without noise and heavy car traffic. And so:

- the number of passenger cars registered in 2015 amounted to 1120.0 thousand; there were 108.6 thousand newly registered cars,
- there were 642 passenger cars per 1000 population,
- there were 1131.4 million passengers during a year,
- there were 14 Bike & Ride parkings with 4634 places,
- in 2015 there were 457.2 kilometres of cycle paths (by 44.7 kilometres more than in a previous year),
- cyclists had at their disposal 219 Veturilo station, 3039 bicycles
- there was a total at 1911 thousand bike rentals during a year.

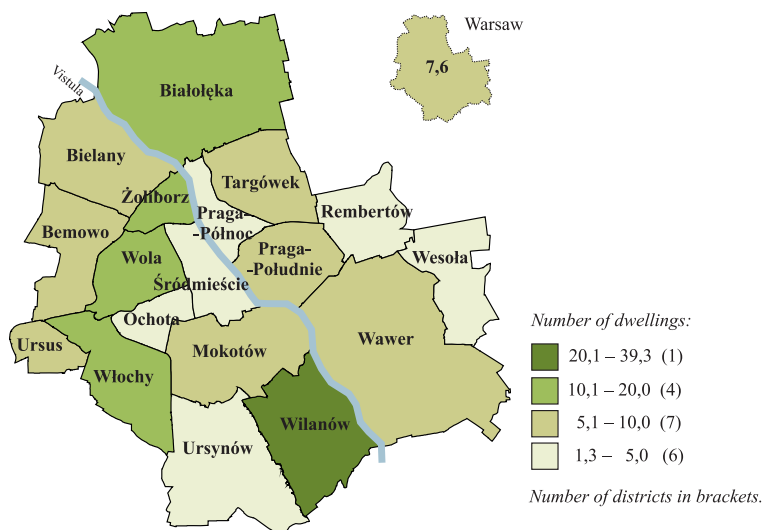
DWELLINGS COMPLETED IN 2015

In 2015 in Warsaw, 13.3 thousand dwellings were completed; number of rooms in these dwellings amounted to 37.3 thousand, and the total usable floor area amounted to 852.3 thousand m². Vast majority of them were dwellings for sale or rent (87.4% of total number); share of private dwellings amounted for 8.3%, co-operative – 3.0%, other forms of housing construction – 1.3%. In comparison with the preceding year the total number of constructed dwellings decreased by 1.7 thousand, i.e. by 11.1%. Increase in the number of dwellings completed was recorded only for public building society construction (by 87.5%). Less dwellings were handed over to other forms of housing construction. The largest decrease occurred in company construction (by 79.7%), while the smallest in private construction (by 2.2%). Dwellings completed in 2015 in Warsaw represent 45.5% of results of housing construction in Mazowieckie voivodship.

Average usable floor area per dwelling amounted to 64.1 m² (by 2.0 m² fewer than a year before). The largest usable floor area was in dwellings completed in districts: Wesoła (156.5 m²) and in Rembertów (119.4 m²), and the smallest in Wola (51.0 m²) and in Bemowo (53.8 m²).

Number of dwellings for which permits have been granted or which have been registered with a construction project amounted to 23.5 thousand, and number of dwellings initiated – to 20.2 thousand. In both cases the figures were bigger than in 2014, by 24.2% and 9.9% respectively.
