LABOUR MARKET

Average employment in Warsaw in enterprise sector in June 2016 amounted to 989.9 thousand people and was by 2.0 thousand people, i.e. 0,2% higher than in May 2016, and by 28.5 thousand people, i.e. 3.0% higher compared with June 2015.

At the end of June 2016 the number of **registered unemployed persons** equated to 37682 and was lower by 887 persons, i.e. 2.3% than at the end of May 2016 and by 7041 persons, i.e. 15.7% lower than during the similar period of the year 2015.

The number of **unemployed women** amounted to 18576 which constituted 49.3% of all unemployed residents (in the previous month 48.6% and in the previous year 47.8%).

The registered unemployment rate equaled 3.2% (in the previous month 3.3% and in the previous year 3.8%).

TRADE

Retail sales in trade and non-trade enterprises in June 2016 (in current prices) was by 4.0% higher than in May 2016 and by 0.9% higher compared with June 2015.

Wholesale in trade enterprises in June 2016 (in current prices) increased by 14.2% as compared with the previous month and increased by 20.2% as compared with June 2015; in wholesale enterprises it was higher by 13.4% and by 15.2% respectively.

INDUSTRY AND CONSTRUCTION

Sold production of industry in June 2016 amounted to (in current prices) 8470.8 mln zl (1914.1 mln EUR¹) and was higher by 4.7% (in constant prices) compared with June 2015.

In January to June 2016 sold production of industry reached 52847.4 mln zl (11941.6 mln EUR¹) (in current prices) and was (in constant prices) higher by 5.1% compared with the same period of 2015.

Sold production of construction in June 2016 stood at (in current prices) 3230.1 mln zl (729.9 mln EUR¹) and compared with May 2016 increased by 1.6%, and compared with the same period of the previous year it was by 11.8% higher.

In January–June 2016 sold production of construction reached 17515.8 mln zl (3957.9 mln EUR¹), i.e. by 13.7% higher than over the same period of 2015.

WAGES AND SALARIES

Average monthly gross wages and salaries in enterprise sector in June 2016 amounted to 5413.32 zl (1223.2 EUR¹) and were 0.9% lower than in May 2016, and 3.8% higher than in the similar period of 2015.

HOUSING CONSTRUCTION

According to preliminary data, 9495 dwellings were completed in Warsaw in January–June 2016 (66.1% more than in the same period of 2015).

In January–June 2016 construction of 10467 dwellings was initiated (28.0% more than during the similar period of 2015).

June 24th POLICE DAY

State Police were established by the Law of the Second Polish Republic on 24th June 1919. We commemorate this event by celebrating June 24th as Police Day.

- According to the data of the National Police Headquarters in Warsaw the number of employees in the Police in 2015 amounted to 8965 persons.
- Women accounted for 28.0% of total employment in the Police, of which female officers 59.4%, civilian workers 40.6%.
- Among the 82.7% of the employed officers and female officers, higher education hold a 49.9% persons, and post-secondary and secondary 50.0%.

MOST RECENT DATA ON PUBLIC SAFETY

In 2015, according to the data of Warsaw Capital City Police Headquarters, 49.0 thousand ascertained crimes were registered in the completed preparatory proceedings. Criminal offences constituted 78.6% of all ascertained crimes, crimes against economy – 14.7%, and road crimes – 4.4%.

In comparison with 2014, there was a 3.3% decrease in the number of ascertained crimes. The number of road crimes and criminal offences diminished by 13.3% and 8.2%, respectively, whereas the number of crimes against economy increased by 30.3%.

The rate of detection of delinquents decreased from 41.1% in 2014 to 39.9% in 2015. The rate of detection of criminal offenders diminished by 2.6 percentage points, of offenders who committed crimes against economy – by 7.6 percentage points and of road offenders – by 0.2 percentage points.

Public order in Warsaw area is protected not only by the Police, but also by the Municipal Police, which in 2015 received 459.0 thousand notifications (i.e. 4.3% more than in 2014), of which 67.8% were reported by the inhabitants of the capital city. The largest number of notifications concerned public order in road traffic (46.0% of all notifications) and safety and maintaining order in public places (35.3%). In 2015 the Municipal Police imposed 633.1 thousand sanctions.

Another formation which deals with public security in Warsaw is State Fire Service that, apart from providing firefighting services, predominantly fights against negative consequences of natural disasters and other local threats, including road accidents. According to the preliminary data of the Municipal Headquarters of the State Fire Service in the capital city of Warsaw, 4906 fires were recorded in 2015 (i.e. by 15.2% more than in 2014). Out of the total number of fires 98.3% were classified as small. In the discussed period the fire service registered 6675 local threats (i.e. by 6.2% more than in 2014) and 2960 false alarms (i.e. by 27.9% more than a year earlier).
