LABOUR MARKET

Average employment in Warsaw in the enterprise sector in June 2017 amounted to 1033.6 thousand persons and was by 3.1 thousand people, i.e. 0.3% higher than in May 2017, and by 43.7 thousand people, i.e. 4.4% higher compared with June 2016

At the end of June 2017 the number of **registered unemployed persons** equalled 30431 and was lower by 1007 persons, i.e. by 3.2% than at the end of May 2017 and by 7251 persons, i.e. 19.2% lower than during the similar period of the year 2016.

The number of **unemployed women** amounted to 15220 which constituted 50.0% of all unemployed (in the previous month 49.7% and in the previous year 49.3%).

The registered unemployment rate was 2.5% (2.6% in the previous month and 3.1% the year before).

TRADE

Retail sales in trade and non-trade enterprises in June 2017 (in current prices) was by 0.9% higher than in May 2017 and by 2.0% higher compared with June 2016.

Wholesale in trade enterprises in June 2017 (in current prices) increased by 3.9% as compared with the previous month and increased by 3.1% as compared with June 2016; in wholesale enterprises it was higher by 4.0% and 3.0% respectively.

INDUSTRY AND CONSTRUCTION

Sold production of industry in June 2017 amounted to (in current prices) 9814.4 mln zl (2322.1 mln EUR¹) and was higher by 17.3% (in constant prices) compared with June 2016.

In January to June 2017 sold production of industry reached 57626.2 mln zl (13634.5 mln EUR¹) (in current prices) and was (in constant prices) higher by 10.0% compared with the same period of 2016.

Sold production of construction in June 2017 amounted to (in current prices) 3827.2 mln zl (905.5 mln EUR¹) and was by 14.6% higher than in May 2017 and by 18.5% higher than over the same period of the previous year.

In January–June 2017 sold production of construction reached 18730.5 mln zl (4431.7 mln EUR¹), i.e. it was by 6.9% higher than over the same period of 2016.

WAGES AND SALARIES

Average monthly gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector in June 2017 amounted to 5715.26 zl (1352.2 EUR¹) and were 1.2% higher than in May 2017, and 5.6% higher than in the similar period of 2016.

HOUSING CONSTRUCTION

According to preliminary data, 7569 dwellings were completed in Warsaw in January–June 2017 (22.0% less than in the same period of 2016).

In January–June 2017 construction of 10361 dwellings was initiated (1.0% less than during the similar period of 2016).

JULY 24th POLICE DAY

State Police were established by the Law of the Second Polish Republic on 24th July 1919. We commemorate this event by celebrating July 24th as Police Day.

- ➤ According to the data of the National Police Headquarters, 48.6 thous. ascertained crimes (i.e. by 0.8% less in comparison to 2015) were noted in Warsaw in 2016.
- ➤ In the structure of crimes according to their nature, criminal crimes prevailed, representing 75.9% of the ascertained crimes in total.
- In 2016, the total rate of detectability of delinquents amounted to 43.1% and was slightly higher in comparison with the previous year.
- In January–December 2016, there were 0.9 thous. road traffic accidents and 27.5 thous. road collisions in Warsaw. Compared with the similar period in 2015, the number of accidents in the city decreased by 0.6% and the number of collisions increased by 11.9%.
- ➤ There were 3 road traffic accident fatalities and 57 road traffic accident injuries calculated per 100 thous. population.

MOST RECENT DATA ON PUBLIC SAFETY IN 2016

In 2016 according to the data of the National Police Headquarters in Warsaw, 48.6 thous. ascertained crimes in completed preparatory proceedings were noted. Criminal crimes represented 75.9% of total ascertained crimes, economic crimes – 16.8% and traffic crimes – 4.4%.

Compared to 2015, there was a drop by 0.8% in the total number of ascertained crimes. The number of criminal crimes was lower by 4.1% and traffic crimes by 0.1%. Whereas, there were more ascertained economic crimes (by 13.7%).

The rate of detectability of delinquents increased from 39.3% in 2015 to 43.1% in 2016. The rate of detectability of delinquents of criminal and economic crimes increased by 2.8 p.p. and 4.3 p.p. respectively, whereas the rate of detectability of delinquents of traffic crimes decreased by 0.5 p.p.

Protection of public order in Warsaw realized by the Police was supported by the Municipal Police, which in 2016 received 529.5 thous. notifications (i.e. by 15.4% more than in 2015), of which 69.4% were notifications from urban inhabitants. The majority of notifications concerned road traffic (50.0% of total notifications) and public safety and maintaining public order (31.7%). In 2016, the Municipal Police imposed 775.5 thous. sanctions in total.

Another formation which ensures public safety in Warsaw is the State Fire Service, which apart from participating in fire rescue operations save from natural disasters and other local threats, predominantly transport accidents. According to preliminary data of the Municipal Headquarters of the State Fire Service in the Capital City of Warsaw, 4447 fires were noted in 2016 (i.e. by 9.4% less in comparison with 2015). Of the total number of fires 99.0% were defined as small fires. In the reference period, 9194 local threats (i.e. by 37.7% more than in 2015) and 5216 false alarms (i.e. by 76.2% more than the year before) were noted.
