LABOUR MARKET

Average employment in Warsaw in the enterprise sector in December 2017 amounted to 1044.8 thousand persons and was by 4.4 thousand people, i.e. 0.4% higher than in November 2017, and by 36.7 thousand people, i.e. 3.6% higher compared with December 2016.

At the end of December 2017 the number of **registered unemployed persons** equalled 26056 and was lower by 541 persons, i.e. by 2.0% than at the end of November 2017 and by 7156 persons, i.e. 21.5% lower than during the similar period of the year 2016.

The number of **unemployed women** amounted to 13070 which constituted 50.2% of all unemployed residents (in the previous month 50.0% and in the previous year 50.1%).

The registered unemployment rate was 2.0% (2.1% in the previous month, 2.6% the year before).

TRADE

Retail sales in trade and non-trade enterprises in December 2017 (in current prices) was by 21.6% higher than in November 2017 and by 2.8% higher compared with December 2016.

Wholesale in trade enterprises in December 2017 (in current prices) decreased by 10.2% as compared with the previous month and by 0.2% as compared with December 2016; in wholesale enterprises it was lower by 12.9% and 5.6% respectively.

INDUSTRY AND CONSTRUCTION

Sold production of industry in December 2017 amounted to (in current prices) 10539.3 mln zl (2526.9 mln EUR¹) and was higher by 5.7% (in constant prices) compared with December 2016.

In January to December 2017 sold production of industry reached 116448.5 mln zl (27919.3 mln EUR¹) (in current prices) and was (in constant prices) higher by 9.4% compared with the same period of 2016.

Sold production of construction in December 2017 amounted to (in current prices) 4522.5 mln zl (1084.3 mln EUR¹) and was by 30.1% higher than in November 2017, and by 6.6% lower than over the same period of the previous year.

In January–December 2017 sold production of industry reached 44314.7 mln zl (10624.7 mln EUR¹), i.e. by 4.3% higher than over the same period of 2016.

WAGES AND SALARIES

Average monthly gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector in December 2017 amounted to 6232.77 zl (1494.3 EUR¹) and were 8.0% higher than in November 2017, and 7.9% higher than in the similar period of 2016.

HOUSING CONSTRUCTION

According to preliminary data, 20105 dwellings were completed in Warsaw in January–December 2017 (0.1% less than in the same period of 2016).

In January–December 2017 construction of 22770 dwellings was initiated (3.5% more than during the similar period of 2016).



SPORT IN WARSAW IN 2016

Warsaw has good conditions for the development of sport. There are many sports and recreational facilities that allows you to practice a number of sports disciplines, including multifunctional stadiums or football stadiums. Thanks to the modernization and renovation of the existing infrastructure, the quality of the sports base of the capital and its accessibility is systematically improving.

One of the biggest sports attractions of the capital is the National Stadium, built for the 2012 UEFA European Championships. It is a multi-purpose sports facility, allowing the organization of sports events, music concerts or cultural events. The stadium has a seating capacity of 58 thousand.

According to the latest statistics from 2016, there were 332 sports clubs operating in Warsaw (57 more than in 2014), which had a total of 55.3 thousand members.


Within two years the number of people actively practicing sport in Warsaw clubs increased by 29.9% and at the end of 2016 amounted to 51.2 thousand. Majority of them (68.0%) were young people up to 18 years of age. As in previous years, men dominated among persons practicing sport.

The same as in 2014, football was the most popular among sport disciplines — 11.8 thousand persons in 73 sections. Other popular sports were: judo (4.6 thousand persons in 32 sections), volleyball (2.8 thousand persons in 40 sections) and swimming (2.5 thousand persons in 35 sections).

Sports activities took place under the direction of 1204 trainers, i.e. by 373 more than in 2014. On average, there were 43 persons practicing sport in sports clubs per one person with appropriate training qualifications (at 47 in 2014).

Compared with 2014, the number of sport instructors decreased by 35, i.e. 3.6% and the number of other persons conducting sports activities decreased by 13.
