

Statistics of Warszawa No. 10/2020

30 November 2020



In October 2020, there was a slight increase in the average employment y/y and an increase in the number of unemployed persons. There were fewer job offers than a year before. There was a slight increase in sold production of industry, whereas construction and assembly production was significantly lower. Trade enterprises recorded a decrease in retail sales and a slight increase in wholesale. October was characterized by a higher number of dwellings completed than in the previous year, while a significantly lower number of dwellings in which construction has begun and permits issued.


Average employment

Average employment in the enterprise sector in October 2020 amounted to 1088.4 thousand persons and was by 1.6 thousand persons, i.e. by 0.1% higher than in September 2020 and by 2.8 thousand persons, i.e. by 0.3% higher than in October 2019.

Compared to September 2020, an increase in the average employment was recorded in the following sections: administrative and support service activities (by 1.5%), arts, entertainment and recreation and industry (by 0.4% each), information and communication (by 0.3%), professional, scientific and technical activities and trade; repair of motor vehicles (by 0.2% each).

Whereas a decrease in the average employment occurred in the sections: accommodation and catering (by 2.2%), construction (by 0.5%), transportation and storage (by 0.4%), real estate activities (by 0.1%).

As compared to October 2019, an increase in the average employment was recorded in the following sections: arts, entertainment and recreation (by 5.1%), industry (by 4.9%), administrative and support service activities (by 2.0%), professional, scientific and technical activities (by 1.6%).

Average employment in the enterprise sector in October 2020 was by 0.3% higher than a year before A decrease in the average employment was recorded in the following sections: accommodation and catering (by 8.1%), trade; repair of motor vehicles (by 1.9%), real estate activities (by 1.6%), construction and information and communication (by 1.4% each), transportation and storage (by 0.2%).

Registerd unemployment

At the end of October 2020, the number of registered unemployed persons amounted to 24468 and was by 43 persons, i.e. by 0.2% larger than at the end of September 2020 and by 7013 persons, i.e. by 40.2% larger than in the corresponding period of 2019.

The number of registered unemployed women amounted to 11967, which accounted for 48.9% of the total unemployed (48.8% a month before, and 50.1% a year before) and 16.4% of unemployed women in Mazowieckie Voivodship. As compared to September 2020, the number of unemployed women increased by 55 persons, i.e. by 0.5%, and compared to October 2019 increased by 3229 persons, i.e. by 37.0%.

The registered unemployment rate amounted to 1.8% (as in the previous month, and 1.3% in the previous year), the average in Mazowieckie Voivodship was 5.1% (as a month before, and 4.3% a year before), while the national average was 6.1% (as a month before, and 5.0% a year before).


In October 2020, there were 2774 unemployed persons registered in labour offices (2683 in September 2020, and 2831 in October 2019). Registered unemployed persons accounted for 20.3% of the total registered unemployed in the voivodship.

The number of persons registering for the first time amounted to 1131 (a month before 891), which accounted for 40.8% of the total unemployed who registered in October 2020 and 27.7% of persons registering for the first time in the voivodship. The share of persons terminated due to company reasons among unemployed persons registered in October 2020 amounted to 4.1% (5.4% in Mazowieckie Voivodship), 4.2% a month before and 2.8% a year before.

In October 2020, 2731 persons were removed from unemployment rolls (2426 in September 2020, and 3545 in October 2019), which accounted for 18.2% of unemployed persons removed from unemployment rolls in Mazowieckie Voivodship. Out of unemployed persons removed from unemployment rolls, 1795 persons took up work. Moreover, 494 persons lost their status of the unemployed as a result of not confirming their readiness to take up work. The reason for removing from the register was also voluntarily giving up the status of the unemployed, acquisition of retirement rights of pre-retirement benefit, acquisition of pension rights, starting training or traineeship and other.

There were 20232 persons who were not entitled to the unemployment benefit, i.e. 82.7% of the total unemployed (14446 persons a year before, i.e. 82.8%). Whereas 4236 unemployed persons were entitled to the unemployment benefit.

In October 2020, there were 3113 job offers submitted to labour offices, which accounted for 23.9% of job offers in Mazowieckie Voivodship and at the end this month the labour offices had job offers for 953 persons. At the end of October 2020, there were 26 persons per one job offer

In October 2020, the upward trend in the number of registered unemployed persons continued and the unemployment rate was at the previous month's level

In October 2020, the number of persons removed from unemployment rolls was by 23.0% smaller than a year before

(18 a month before and 12 a year before), in Mazowieckie Voivodship 23 persons (17 in the previous month and 14 in the previous year) registered as unemployed.


Wages and salaries

The average monthly gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector in October 2020 amounted to PLN 6891.68 and were by 5.1% higher as compared to the previous month and by 3.1% higher than in the corresponding period of 2019.

Compared to September 2020, the increase in the average gross wages and salaries was recorded in the following sections: construction (by 22.2%), transportation and storage (by 19.7%), arts, entertainment and recreation (by 19.3%), trade; repair of motor vehicles (by 3.4%), real estate activities (by 2.8%), administrative and support service activities (by 0.8%), industry (by 0.5%), accommodation and catering (by 0.2%).

Whereas the decrease in the average gross wages and salaries occurred in the section of information and communication (by 1.7%) and professional, scientific and technical activities (by 1.4%).

Compared to October 2019, an increase in the average gross wages and salaries was recorded in the sections: arts, entertainment and recreation (by 15.1%), construction (by 12.6%), real estate activities (by 7.4%), administrative and support service activities (by 6.6%), information and communication (by 4.7%), trade; repair of motor vehicles and industry (by 4.3% each), professional, scientific and technical activities (by 3.0%).

Whereas the decrease in the average gross wages and salaries occurred in the sections accommodation and catering (by 4.7%) and transportation and storage (by 4.0%).

Industry

Sold production of industry in October 2020 amounted (at current prices) to PLN 12270.4 million and was (at constant prices) larger as compared to the corresponding period of 2019 by 2.2%. As compared to October 2019, an increase by 10.1% was recorded in sold production in manufacturing.

In the period January-October 2020, the sold production of industry amounted to PLN 113079.1 million (at current prices) and was (at constant prices) higher by 9.2% than in the corresponding period of 2019. In manufacturing, production increased by 10.3%.

Among divisions included in manufacturing, the sales increase was recorded, among others, in: manufacture of pharmaceutical products (by 46.8%), manufacture of textiles (by 33.0%), manufacture of food products (by 28.4%), manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 20.5%), manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (by 18.5%), other manufacturing (by 10.5%), manufacture of electrical equipment (by 8.4%), repair and installation of machinery and equipment (by 8.2%), manufacture of metal products (by 8.0%), manufacture of rubber and plastic products (by 7.3%), manufacture of furniture (by 6.0%), manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 1.9%), manufacture of metals (by 0.4%), manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.1%).

Average monthly gross wages and salaries in the enterprise sector in October 2020 amounted to PLN 6891.68 and were by 3.1% higher than in October 2019

Sold production in manufacturing (at constant prices) in October 2020 was by 10.1% larger than a year before The decrease in sales was recorded, among others, in: manufacture of other transport equipment (by 24.6%), manufacture of leather and related products (by 22.4%), printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 15.3%), manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products (by 9.4%), manufacture of machinery and equipment n.e.c. (by 7.5%), manufacture of wearing apparel (by 5.5%), manufacture of beverages (by 5.4%), manufacture of paper and paper products (by 2.4%), manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products (by 0.9%).

Labour productivity in industry, measured by the value of sold production per employed person in January-October 2020 amounted to PLN 603.7 thousand (at current prices) and was – at constant prices – by 4.1% higher than a year before.

Construction

Sold production of construction in October 2020 amounted (at current prices) to PLN 3940.7 million and compared to September 2020 was smaller by 9.9%, and compared to the corresponding period of the previous year it decreased by 20.1%.

In January-October 2020, sold production of construction reached the value of PLN 42063.4 million, i.e. by 6.6% smaller than in the corresponding period of 2019.

Construction and assembly production in October 2020 reached PLN 1058.1 million (at current prices) and accounted for 26.9% of sold production of construction. As compared to the previous month, construction and assembly production decreased by 3.3%, and compared to October 2019 it was lower by 18.7%.

In the period January–October 2020, construction and assembly production amounted to PLN 10154.9 million and constituted 24.1% of the sold production of construction (24.2% a year before). In comparison with the same period last year, construction and assembly production was lower by 6.9%.

The decrease in production in relation to the corresponding period of 2019 occurred in entities dealing with: construction of buildings (by 21.1%), civil engineering (by 6.0%), whereas an increase in production was noted in units performing specialized construction activities (by 14.8%).

Labour productivity measured by production per employed person in construction, in October 2020 amounted to PLN 77.2 thousand and was by 9.5% lower than a month before and by 19.0% lower than in October 2019.

Trade

Retail sales in trade and non-trade enterprises in October 2020 (at current prices) were by 2.1% larger than in September 2020 and by 2.4% lower compared to October 2019.

Compared to September 2020, there was an increase in retail sales conducted by mail order houses (by 17.5%), sales of furniture, electronics and household appliances (by 9.6%), sales of food, beverages and tobacco (by 5.8%), sales of motor vehicles, motorcycles, parts (by 1.0%).

Whereas there was a decrease in the sales of textiles, clothing and footwear (by 7.6%), other retail sales in non-specialized stores (by 5.1%), sales of press, books, other sales in specialized stores (by 3.7%), sales of pharmaceuticals, cosmetics, orthopedic equipment (by 2.6%), sales of solid, liquid and gas fuels (by 1.7%), other sales (by 1.3%).

Compared to October 2019, there was a decrease in sales of textiles, clothing and footwear (by 26.1%), other sales (by 16.6%), sales of solid, liquid and gas fuels (by 13.9%), sales of pharmaceuticals, cosmetics, orthopedic equipment (by 9.0%), other retail sales in non-specialized stores (by 7.2%), sales of motor vehicle, motorcycles, parts (by 5.0%), sales of food, beverages and tobacco (by 2.0%), sales of press, books, other sales in specialized stores (by 0.5%).

However, there was an increase in retail sales conducted by mail order houses (by 75.4%), sales furniture, electronics and household appliances (by 16.4%). In January-October 2020, compared to the corresponding period of 2019, retail sales decreased by 5.4%.

Wholesale in trade enterprises in October 2020 (at current prices) was by 2.8% higher as compared to the previous month and by 0.6% higher as compared to October 2019, and in wholesale enterprises it was higher by 2.5% and lower by 2.7%, respectively.

In the period January-October 2020, trade units realized wholesale by 4.0% smaller than in the previous year, while wholesale enterprises by 3.4% smaller.

Construction and assembly production (at current prices) in October 2020 was by 18.7% smaller than a year before

Retail sales (at current prices) in trade and non-trade enterprises in October 2020 was by 2.4% smaller than in October 2019

Compared to October 2019, the sales of textiles, clothing and footwear as well as other sales decreased the most


Wholesale (at current prices) in trade enterprises was by 0.6% higher than a year before

Housing construction¹

According to preliminary data, 2087 dwellings were completed in Warszawa in October 2020, i.e. by 1.5% more than in the previous year.

In January–October 2020, there were 19191 completed dwellings (by 11.4% more than in the corresponding period of 2019), and in Mazowieckie Voivodship 37560 dwellings, i.e. by 8.5% more than in January–October 2019. The increase in the number of dwellings completed was recorded in municipal construction from 12 to 100 dwellings, in construction for sale or rent from 16405 to 18359 dwellings, i.e. by 11.9% more, in private construction from 432 to 477 dwellings, i.e. by 10.4% more. Whereas a decrease in the number of dwellings completed was recorded in cooperative construction from 353 to 40 dwellings, i.e by 88.7% less. Moreover, 215 dwellings were completed by public building societies.

In January–October 2020, the construction began in 12442 dwellings (by 34.9% less than in the corresponding period of 2019), of which: 11953 in construction for sale or rent, 462 in private construction, 27 in cooperative construction.

In January–October 2020, the number of dwellings for which permits have been granted or which have been registered with a construction project amounted to 12474 (by 34.1% less than in the corresponding period of 2019), of which 504 dwellings in buildings built by private investors.

The average useful floor area of a dwelling completed in January–October 2020, amounted to $58.2~\text{m}^2$ and decreased compared to the corresponding period of 2019 by $2.1~\text{m}^2$. In private construction, the average useful floor area of dwellings amounted to $201.1~\text{m}^2$ (by $1.7~\text{m}^2$ more than in the corresponding period of 2019), in cooperative construction $-58.8~\text{m}^2$ (by $1.3~\text{m}^2$ more), in construction for sale or rent $-54.8~\text{m}^2$ (by $2.0~\text{m}^2$ fewer), in municipal construction $-44.5~\text{m}^2$ (by $3.7~\text{m}^2$ more), in dwellings built by public building societies $-41.5~\text{m}^2$.

Entities of the national economy²

At the end of October 2020 there were 472215 entities of the national economy registered in the REGON register in Warszawa, which accounted for 53.5% of the total in Mazowieckie Voivodship. Compared with September 2020, the number of entities of the national economy increased by 1986 (i.e. by 0.4%), and compared to October 2019 increased by 19180 (i.e. by 4.2%).

As of the end of October this year, there were 211093 legal persons and organizational units without legal personality registered in the REGON register, of which 143782 commercial companies. The number of these entities increased compared to the previous month by 0.4% and 0.5%, whereas on an annual basis by 5.1% and 6.9%, respectively.

The number of registered natural persons conducting economic activity as of the end of October this year amounted to 261122 and compared to September 2020 it was higher by 0.5%, and compared to the corresponding period of the previous year increased by 3.6%.

In January–October 2020, the construction began in 12442 dwellings, i.e. by 34.9% less than in the corresponding period of the previous year


At the end of October 2020, the most numerous group of entities by kind of conducted activity represented units dealing with professional, scientific and technical activities

In the capital city, in October 2020 the most numerous were entities dealing with professional, scientific and technical activities (19.5% of total registered units), trade; repair of motor vehicles (18.7%), information and communication (10.0%).

Compared to September 2020, the number of entities increased among others in the sections: electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 1.9%), arts, entertainment and recreation (by 0.8%), information and communication and health care and social welfare (by 0.7%). Whereas a decrease in the number of entities was noted in the section of water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (by 0.8%).

In comparison with October 2019, the largest increase was recorded in the sections: electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (by 27.9%), information and communication (by 8.0%), administrative and support service activities (by 7.2%). Whereas a decrease in the number of entities was recorded in the section of mining and quarrying (by 1.6%).

In October 2020, 3044 new entities were entered into the REGON register, i.e. by 1.7% less than in the previous month. The newly registered entities were dominated by natural persons conducting economic activity – 1947 (by 5.4% more than in September 2020). The number of newly registered commercial companies was lower by 13.7%, including limited liability companies – by 12.8%.

In October 2020, 972 entities were removed from the REGON register (compared to 1044 in the previous month), including 670 natural persons conducting economic activity (by 9.6% less). The most deregistered units were dealing with: trade; repair of motor vehicles (19.7%) professional, scientific and technical activities (by 17.0%).

As of the end of October this year, 42518 entities had suspended activity in the REGON register (by 1.2% more than a month before). The vast majority were natural persons conducting economic activity (85.4%).

In October 2020, the number of newly registered entities was 1.7% lower than a month earlier, and the number of suspended activities increased by 1.2%
