


# Economic activity of population in Mazowieckie Voivodship in the third quarter of 2023 <sup>1</sup>

**28 December 2023** 




In Q3 2023, there was an increase in the number of employed and unemployed persons compared to Q2 2023. Unemployed men looked for a job longer than women, and unemployed urban residents shorter than rural residents.

### Economic activity of population aged 15-89 according to LFS

In the third quarter of 2023, among the total population of Mazowieckie Voivodship aged 15-89, 61.3% represented employed persons, 1.6% – unemployed, and 37.2% – economically inactive persons. This means that less than half of the population aged 15-89 (38.8%) did not work. In urban and rural areas this structure looked similar. However, significant differences were visible in the structure of men and women. Without employment (economically inactive and unemployed) were 32.4% of men and 44.4% of women.

Chart 1. Structure of population aged 15-89 by sex in Q3 2023




Compared to the second quarter of 2023, the number of employed persons increased by 0.3%, and of unemployed persons by 13.1%. The number of economically inactive persons increased (by 0.9%). A decrease in the ratio of non-working population over working population was observed as well. In the third quarter of 2023, there were 633 unemployed and economically inactive persons per 1,000 employed persons, while in the second quarter of 2023 – 637.



Chart 2. Changes in the economic activity of population compared to Q2 2023



The economic activity rate was 62.9% and increased by 0.1 pp compared to the previous quarter. There was an increase in the level of economic activity both among men (by 0.5 pp) as well as women (by 0.2%). This indicator increased in urban areas (by 0.9 pp) and decreased (by 0.5 pp) in rural areas.

Chart 3. Economic activity of population in Q3 2023




The highest value of the rate in terms of age was recorded for the age group 35–44, which amounted to 91.9%, while the lowest among persons aged 55-89 – 31.0%. For working age population, this rate was 84.9%.

## **Employed persons**

In the third quarter of 2023, in Mazowieckie Voivodship, the population of employed persons counted 2638 thousand persons, and the employment rate was estimated at 61.3% (a 0.2 pp increase compared to the previous quarter).

Compared to the second quarter of 2023, the number of employed persons increased 0.3%. There was an increase among men (by 0.8%) and a decrease among women (by 0.2%). The number of employed persons increased in urban (by 1.0%) and decreased in rural areas (by 1.1%).

In the third quarter of 2023, the highest employment rate was recorded among persons aged 35–44 (90.1%), and the lowest among persons aged 15-24 (28.3%). The highest increase of the rate was recorded among persons aged 35–44 (by 0.1 pp), and the highest decrease among persons aged 15-24 (by 1.8 pp).


For working age population, the employment rate reached 82.8% (no changes compared to the second quarter of 2023).

Among employed persons according to the level of education, the highest employment rate recorded persons with higher education – 82.7%, and the lowest among persons with lower secondary and less education – 16.8%. The highest increase in the employment rate occurred among persons with lower secondary and less education (by 0.9 pp), and the largest decrease among persons with post-secondary and vocational secondary, sectoral education (by 1.9 pp).

In the third quarter of 2023, there were 2091 thousand persons employed in the public and private sector (i.e. 79.3% of total employees), and their number increased by 1.7% compared to the second quarter of 2023. There was a decrease among employers and self-employed persons (from 529 thousand to 523 thousand), and among contributing family workers (from 45 thousand to 24 thousand). The vast majority of employed persons supported the private sector (69.3% of the total). Of these, the majority (52.8%) were men. The situation was different among persons employed in the public sector, where among 643 thousand employed persons predominated women (62.4%). There were 85.7% of employees employed for an indefinite period (a 0.8 pp decrease compared to the second quarter of 2023).

More than 69% of total employed persons worked in the private sector

### **Unemployed persons**

In the third quarter of 2023, the population of unemployed persons (aged 15-74) in Mazowieckie Voivodship amounted to 69 thousand persons and increased by 13.1% compared to the second quarter of 2023.

Compared to the previous quarter, the number of unemployed men decreased (by 3.3%), and the number of women increased (by 25.8%). There was an increase both among urban (by 18.9%), and among rural residents (by 4.2%).

The number of unemployed men decreased by more than 3%, and the number of women increased by nearly 26% The total unemployment rate in the Voivodship amounted to 2.5% and increased compared to the second quarter of 2023. In urban areas it was 2.5% (by 0.2 pp lower than in rural areas). For working age population the unemployment rate was 2.5%.

Compared to the second quarter of 2023, the unemployment rate did not change among men, and increased among women (by 0.6 pp). There was an increase in urban (by 0.4 pp), and in rural areas (by 0.2 pp).

An average time of job seeking by unemployed persons amounted to 6.6 months. Men looked for a job for 7.2 months on average (by 1.1 months longer than women), and urban residents for 6.4 months (by 0.6 months shorter than rural residents).


Men looked for a job longer than women, and urban residents shorter than rural residents

# **Economically inactive persons**

In the third quarter of 2023, in Mazowieckie Voivodship, 1600 thousand persons remained economically inactive, which accounted for 37.2% of total population aged 15-89 (in urban areas – 36.1% and in rural areas – 39.0%). Still, in this population women were the majority – 60.5%. Among economically inactive persons, persons with post-secondary and vocational secondary, sectoral education predominated – 25.5%. Working age population made up 28.4% of total economically inactive persons.

Compared to the second quarter of 2023, the population of economically inactive persons decreased by 0.9% (among men it decreased by 1.6%, and among women by 0.5%). Taking into account the place of residence, there was a decrease in the number of economically inactive persons among urban residents (by 2.4%), and an increase among rural residents (by 1.5%).

Out of total economically inactive persons (aged 15-74), 51.5% accounted for persons who did not seek work because of being retired. Other reasons for economic inactivity were: education and training – 24.5%, illness or disability – 9.4%, family and household responsibilities – 6.7%.
