

Tourism in Mazowieckie voivodship in 2017

22.7% share of foreign tourists visiting Poland

Mazowieckie voivodship, despite the low share in the resources of national accommodation establishments (5.2% of the number of facilities and 7.3% of bed places) in 2017 accepted 15.9% of total tourists and 22.7% foreign tourists. In 2017, Mazowieckie voivodship was visited by 5 092.0 thous. tourists who spent here 8 880.0 thous. nights.



Tourist accommodation establishments

On 31 July 2017, there were 554 tourist accommodation facilities in Mazowieckie voivodship (of these 514 open all year). During a year, the number of accommodation facilities increased by 4.9% (by 26 facilities). More than half (57.9%) of tourist accommodation facilities were located in Warszawski stołeczny region.

The accommodation establishments consisted of 345 hotels and similar establishments (hotels, motels, boarding houses and other hotel facilities) and 209 other facilities². The largest group among hotels and similar facilities, as in previous years, were hotels – 258 facilities (by 2.8% more compared to 2016). The next group in terms of the number were other hotel facilities (hotels, motels, boarding houses which were not assigned any category, as well as other facilities providing hotel services such as guest houses and inns). On 31 July 2017, there were 69 such facilities; no changes compared to the previous year.

¹ The statistical survey of tourist accommodation establishments is conducted on a monthly basis using KT-1 forms. The survey provides information on the condition and occupancy rate of tourist accommodation facilities with 10 and more beds. Since 2016, the data have been presented using the imputation for entities that refused to take part in the survey. The data for 2016 were changed compared to the previous edition of the publication "Tourism in Mazowieckie voivodship in 2016".

On July 2017, there were 554 tourist accommodation facilities in Mazowieckie voivodship, of which almost 60% were located in Warszawski stołeczny region.

² Excursion hostels, shelters, youth hostels, school youth hostels, holiday centres, holiday youth centres, training-recreational centres, creative arts centres, complexes of tourist cottages, camping sites, tent camp sites, hostels, health establishments, rooms for rent, agrotourism lodgings, other not classified establishments.

Among other facilities, the most numerous were agrotourism lodgings – 42 (by 4.5% less than in 2016).

At the end of July 2017, there were 56 704 bed places in tourist accommodation facilities (by 6.1% more than in the corresponding period of 2016). More than ¾ of bed places (75.4%) were in facilities located in Warszawski stołeczny region. In the total number of places – 92.8% were open all year (by 0.9 pp less than a year before).

According to the compiled data, one facility in the voivodship had an average of 102 bed places on their disposal. In the Warszawski stołeczny region, one facility had an average of 133 bed places, while in Mazowiecki regional region over two times less – 60.



The largest number of bed places offered hotels (38 313), i.e. 89.2% in the group hotels and similar facilities and 67.6% of all bed places in the voivodship. In comparison to the corresponding period of the previous year, the number of bed places increased by 1.8%. In 2017, there was an average of 149 bed places per one hotel.

The distribution of tourist accommodation establishments in Mazowieckie voivodship is uneven. In July 2017, most tourist accommodation facilities were located in the Capital City of Warszawa (168 facilities, i.e. 30.3% of total tourist accommodation facilities in the voivodship) and powiats: Legionowski (24), Pruszkowski (23), Piaseczyński (21), Warszawski zachodni (19) and Wołomiński (18). Majority of bed places offered facilities located in the Capital City of Warszawa (54.7% of all places in the voivodship) and in powiats: Legionowski (6.8%), Siedlce (2.6%), Pruszkowski and Warszawski zachodni (both 2.3%), Piaseczyński (2.1%) and łosicki (2.0%). The smallest number of bed places were offered by tourist accommodation facilities in the powiats: Żuromiński, Zwoleński, Lipski and Makowski (by 0.1% each).

There were 56.7 thous. bed places in tourist accommodation facilities in Mazowieckie voivodship

Catering establishments in tourist accommodation facilities

At the end of July 2017, in tourist accommodation facilities operated 547 catering establishments (by 28 more than in the previous year). The largest group were restaurants – 277 (50.6%), followed by bars and cafes – 172 (31.4%), canteens – 64 (11.7%) and food stands – 34 (6.2%). In the analyzed period, 449 catering establishments were located in hotels and similar establishments (by 10 more than in July 2016), which accounted for 82.1% of total establishments. Majority of catering establishments were located in hotels (371), in other hotel facilities (64) and training-recreational centres (38). Out of total establishments in hotels, majority were located in 3-star hotels – 101 restaurants, i.e. 46.5% of all restaurants in hotels and 36.5% of total restaurants in tourist accommodation facilities as well as 53 bars and cafes (analogically 46.9% and 30.8%).


Occupancy of tourist accommodation facilities

In 2017, 5 092.0 thous. persons used tourist accommodation establishments (by 7.5% more than a year before). As in the previous year, most popular among tourists were hotels which accepted 4 348.6 thous. persons (more by 5.9% compared to 2016), in other hotel facilities – 263.1 thous. (an increase by 23.8%), hostels – 159.7 thous. (an increase by 28.0%) and in training-recreational centres – 118.7 thous. (a 20.8% increase). More than 87% of tourists chose accommodation in facilities located in Warszawski stołeczny region.

Map 2. Occupancy rate of bed places in tourist accommodation facilities by powiats in 2017




In 2017, 5 092.0 thous. tourists used tourist accommodation facilities, of these majority stayed in hotels

Tourists who in 2017 visited Mazowieckie voivodship spent here 8 880.0 thous. nights (by 9.1% more than in the previous year). The largest number of nights spent were reported in hotels 7 144.5 thous. (an increase by 5.8%), other hotel facilities 472.0 thous. (an increase by 21.6%), hostels 347.1 thous. (an increase by 55.6%) and in training-recreational centres 251,3 thous. (an increase by 17,2%). The largest number of nights were spent in August and September – 9.7% each of their total number in the voivodship. Almost 86% of nights spent were allocated to facilities located in the Warszawski stołeczny region.

The average length of stay of tourists in tourist accommodation facilities in total in 2017 amounted to (as in the previous year) 1.7 days, and it was the longest in holiday months and in February (1.8–1.9 days). In facilities located in Warszawski stołeczny region, the tourists stayed on average of 1.7 days, in facilities of Mazowiecki regional region slightly longer – 2.0 days.

Most tourists stayed in 3-and 4-star hotels, a total of 63.4% of total guests in hotels. Among motels and boarding houses the largest number of tourists, nights spent and rented rooms were recorded in 2-star facilities.



The most popular were hotels with 80.5% of total nights spent

In 2017, in hotels and similar facilities 5 949.7 thous. rooms were rented (an increase by 6.0% compared to 2016). Most, as many as 4 757.2 thous. rooms, were rented in hotels (an increase by 5.2%). Occupancy of rooms in hotels, motels, boarding houses and other hotel facilities in 2017 amounted to 62.0%, i.e. by 2.5 pp more than in 2016. The highest occupancy rate of rooms in this type of facilities was recorded in September 71.3%, while the lowest in January – 49.4%. More than 88% of rooms were rented in hotel facilities located in Warszawski stołeczny region. Here, the occupancy rate of rooms was much higher (66.0%) than in facilities located in Mazowiecki regional region (43.3%).


Figure 3. Occupancy rate of rooms in hotels and similar facilities in 2017 (in %)



Occupancy rate of bed places in total tourist accommodation facilities in 2017 amounted to 45.9% and over the analyzed year increased by 2.1 pp. The highest rate was noted in June and September (51.5% each). The occupancy rate of bed places in hotels and similar facilities amounted to 49.3% (by 1.9 pp more than a year before), and in other facilities 32.1% (by 4.3 pp more).

Higher rate was recorded for bed places in facilities located in Warszawski stołeczny region – 50.2%, lower in the case of Mazowiecki regional region – 30.4%. Among powiats and cities with powiat status, the highest occupancy rate concerned bed places in Pułtuski powiat (75.5%), the Capital City of Warszawa (56.5%) and Ostrołęka (49.8%), and the lowest in the powiats Żuromiński (2.7%) and Lipski (4.0%).

Foreign tourists

In Mazowieckie voivodshp in 2017, foreigners using tourist accommodation establishments made up 30.4% of total tourists accommodated in tourist facilities (1 547.3 thous.). The vast majority of foreign tourists (94.6%) stayed in facilities located in Warszawski stołeczny region. It is connected with a very well developed tourist infrastructure in the Capital City of


Foreign tourists accounted for 30.4% of total tourists accommodated in Mazowieckie voivodship Warszawa and with good communication accessibility, mainly thanks to flight connections. Foreigners visiting the Capital City of Warszawa accounted for 86.6% of foreign tourists who came to Mazowieckie voivodship.

Majority of foreign tourists visiting Mazowieckie voivodship came from Europe – 1 073.7 thous. (by 4.3% more than a year before) and accounted for 69.4% of total foreign tourists. Mazowieckie voivodship was also visited by: 265.9 thous. tourists from Asia; 139.6 thous. from North America; 14.3 thous. from South and Central America; 13.2 thous. from Australia and Oceania and 7.5 thous. from Africa. The vast majority of foreign tourists (91.3%) stayed in hotels. Foreigners accounted for 32.5% of total hotel guests, and their share was the highest in 5-star hotels and amounted to 62.0%. In 2017, guests from abroad rented 1 807.6 thous. rooms, i.e. by 3.6% more than in the previous year. Most rooms were rented in August (186.8 thous.), September (185.4 thous.) and in July (184.2 thous.).

In 2017, foreign tourists spent 3 016.4 thous. nights in the voivodship (by 8.6% more than in 2016), which accounted for 34.0% of total nights spent (a decrease compared to 2016 by 0.1 pp).

Majority of nights, as in the previous year, were spent in hotels — 2 669.1 thous., i.e. 88.5% of all nights spent by this type of tourists in accommodation facilities. The average length of stay of foreign tourist in Mazovia amounted to 1.9 days (the same as in 2016).

Foreign tourists most often chose hotels as their accommodation place – almost 89% of nights spent




