

Foreigners on the Masovian labour market in 2023


Decrease in the number of work permits issued for foreigners y/y The year 2023 in Mazowieckie Voivodship was third in a row in which the number of work permits for foreigners decreased annually and amounted to almost 65 thousand. Work permits were most often issued to Indian citizens (almost 10 thousand) and this number increased by over 18% annually.

Data on permits issued for foreigners to work in Poland are available in two ways, i.e. according to the location of the authority issuing the permit and according to the place of work of the person to whom the permit applies. The data in the News release are presented according to the place of work of foreigners, which means that they concern persons whose declared place of work is Mazowieckie Voivodship.

In 2023, 65.3 thousand work permits for foreigners were issued in Mazowieckie Voivodship, (2.2% less than a year before). The next voivodships in this respect were voivodships Wielko-polskie – 39.7 thousand, Śląskie – 37.4 thousanad and Pomorskie – 30.1 thousand.

The largest number – 9.6 thousand, i.e. 14.6% of work permits for foreigners were granted to citizens of India (in 2022 – 8.1 thousand, i.e. 12.1%). Next, work permits were issued to citizens of Turkey (8.9 thousand compared to 8.5 thousand in 2022; an increase of 4.3%), Nepal (5.9 thousand compared to 3.6 thousand; increase by 66.5%) and Philippines (4.6 thousand compared by 2.5 thousand; increase by 82.4%). The number of permits issued in 2023 to Ukrainian citizens decreased by 88.1% and amounted to 1.6 thousand.

Chart 1. Structure of work permits for foreigners by citizenship in 2023




The vast majority of issued work permits concerned men. Their share in the total number of all permits issued in Mazowieckie Voivodship in 2023 amounted to 83.6% (83.3% in 2022). The predominance of men in terms of permits occurred in all voivodships (from 80.5% in Zachodniopomorskie to 92.1% in Podlaskie). In the country, this share was on average 85.0%. The number of permits issued in Mazowieckie Voivodship compared to 2022 was lower for women by 3.7% and for men by 1.9%.

Nearly 84% of work permits were issued to men






The largest group of foreigners who received work permits were persons aged 25–34 (41.3%) and 35–44 (29.4%). This percentage was similar among both sexes (respectively: men – 41.1% and 29.6%; women – 42.7% and 28.9%).

More than 2/5 of work permits were issued to persons aged 25-34, and almost 1/3 to persons aged 35-44

Work permits for foreigners in Mazowieckie Voivodship, as in 2022, were issued for longer periods of time. In 2023, the majority (47.4% compared to 49.1% in 2022) of work permits were issued for a period of more than 24 months, followed by for the period from 6 to 12 months (38.1% compared to 40.7%). On the other hand, the permits with the shortest validity period, i.e. up to 6 months, constituted only 0.2% of their total number.

Most (51.2%) work permits concerned employment contracts, followed by order-agreements (45.3%).

Almost half of the work permits were issued for a period longer than 24 months





In 2023, as in the previous year, the most permits were issued to employers from the construction section (16.5 thousand), which accounted for 25.3% of total permits (compared to 29.1% in 2022), followed by employers from the transportation and storage section (20.8% compared to 19.9%), as well as manufacturing (19.6% compared to 13.9%)




Chart 5. Structure of work permits for foreigners by selected PKD sections in 2023

Most (more than 1/4) work permits were issued in construction

In 2023, foreigners who obtained a work permit in Mazowieckie Voivodshp, as in 2022, most often worked as industrial workers and craftsmen – 36.0%, workers performing elementary occupations – 22.7%, as well as office clerks – 12.7%.
