

Out-patient health care in Mazowieckie Voivodship in 2020

29 June 2021



At the end of 2020, out-patient health care was carried out by 3097 thousand out-patient departments and 256 thousand doctors and dentists practices providing services funded by public sources. In 2020, 44.4 million out-patient consultations were privided - 39.8 million doctors and 4.6 million dentists consultations.

Outpatient departments and doctors practices

At the end of 2020, 3353 thousand providers of out-patient health care were operating, of which 3097 outpatient departments¹ as well as 31 doctors practices and 225 dentists practices providing services funded by public sources.

At the end of 2020, 18% of out-patient departments were funded by public sources

In comparison with the previous year, the number of out-patient health care providers decreased by 0.5% in total. Out-patient departments in urban areas decreased by 0.3%, while in rural areas there was an increase by 1.3%. The number of doctors and dentists practices

both in rural and urban areas decreased, the total number of doctors practices by 8.8% and dentists practices by 5.9%.

At the end of 2020, there were 1618 persons per 1 out-patient health care provider (by 8 persons more than a year before).

In Mazowieckie Voivodship, 93.5% of out-patient health care providers were adapted to the needs of the disabled. 67.9% of entities were equipped with ramps or platforms facilitating the entrance to the building, 31.4% had non-slip floors and 29.5% an elevator. 3.1% of out-patient health care providers had facilities for the visually impaired and the blind, and 2.0% for the hearing impaired and deaf.

Out-patient consultations

In 2020, there were 44360.5 thousand out-patient consultations provided (of which 11907.0 thousand online consultations). Compared to 2019, there were less out-patient consultations provided by 10.9% in Mazowieckie Voivodship. The vast majority of consultations (86.2%) were provided in urban areas. 45.2% of out-patient consultations were provided in primary health care, and 54.8% were specialized consultations, of which 10.3% were provided by dentists.

The average number of out-patient consultations per capita in 2020 was 8.2, with the indicator over three times higher in urban than in rural areas and amounted to 10.9 and 3.2, respectively.

Out-patient consultations were more often provided to women. In the field of specialist care they constituted 61.2%, while in primary care — 57.9%.

In 2020, over half — 54.2% of consultations were provided to persons aged 18-64, in the age group 65 years and more — 29.2%, and at the age 0-17 years — 16.5%.

Children and youth in the age group 0-17 years were provided with 7340.9 thousand consultations, of which 49.1% in primary health care (a decrease of 2.6 pp per year), 34.8% were specialized doctors consultations (an increase of 2.2 pp per year), and 16.1% dentists consultations (increase by 0.4 pp per year).

In the age group 65 and more, 13,915.8 thousand consultations were provided, the most in primary health care -52.4% (increase by 0.1 pp per year), then 41.2% of specialized doctors care (as in the previous year) and 6.4% of dentists care (decrease by 0.2 pp per year).


In 2020, the number of doctors practices decreased, mainly in urban areas

Almost every fourth out-patient consultations is online consultation

On average, there were nearly 3.5-many times more out-patient consultations per urban than per rural inhabitant


Almost 60% of total out-patient health care consultations were provided to women In the age group 65 and more, 12,967.1 thousand consultations were provided, the most in primary health care — 55.7% (increase by 3.3 pp per year), then 39.0% of specialized doctors care (a decrease by 2.2%) and 5.3% of dentists care (a decrease by 1.1 pp per year).

As in the previous year, most (2.9 million) doctors consultations in specialized care were provided in surgical out-patient clinics

In 2020, the number of specialized consultations in mental health clinics increased to 1.2 million
