## Employed persons in the national economy living in Mazowieckie Voivodship in 2022

# **42.0 years**


Median age of employed persons at the end of December 2022

At the end of December 2022, the median age of persons employed in the national economy in Mazowieckie Voivodship was 42.0 years (the same for men and women). The mean age was 42.4 years and was similar for men and women.

With the publication of data for December 2022, there was a change in the structure of data sources in Persons Employed in the National Economy survey, consisting in an increase in the share of data prepared on the basis of administrative sources. So far, the basic source of data have been reports from entities of the national economy. The development of a methodology for obtaining information about employees from official registers made it possible to increase the use of administrative data in research and the frequency of their publication. At the end of December 2022, the number of inhabitants of Mazowieckie Voivodship employed in the national economy amounted to 2,437.3 thousand (16.1% of all persons employed in Poland). The majority, i.e. 66.5%, lived in urban areas (of which 37.1% in the Voivodship capital). There were more men among employed persons; they constituted 51.1% of the discussed population. The highest percentage of men was recorded in the rural gminas of Ceranów (62.1%) and Czarnia (60.7%). Women constituted the majority in only 12 out of 314 gminas (from 50.2% in the following gminas: urban-rural Grodzisk Mazowiecki, rural Jabłonna and urban Mińsk Mazowiecki to 51.6% in m.st. Warszawa).

Almost 67% of employed persons from Mazowieckie Voivodship lived in urban areas

In m.st. Warszawa, the share of women in the total number of employed residents was the highest in the Voivodship (almost 52%) The vast majority of persons employed in the national economy residing in Mazowieckie Voivodship are employees - their share in the total working population was 78.5%; among women, employees constituted 84.3%, and among men 73.7%. The largest number of employees were employed in the trade; repair of motor vehicles section (16.8%), followed by manufacturing (14.3%) and education (9.8%). The sections with the lowest employment were agriculture, forestry, and fishing (0.5% of all employees), activities related to culture, entertainment and recreation (1.4%) and real estate activities (1.5%).

More than 3/4 of employed inhabitants of Mazowieckie Voivodship were employees





The majority (just over 51%) of the employed inhabitants of the Voivodship were men (in urban areas over 49%, in rural areas over 54%)

As at the end of December 2022, in Mazowieckie Voivodship the median age of employed persons was (as in the country) 42.0 years. This means that half of the working population has already reached this age and the other half has not yet reached this age. The highest median age value was recorded in Podkowa Leśna gmina – 48.0 years. The lowest median age – 40.0 years – occurred in 16 gminas of the Voivodship (15 rural gminas and m.st. Warszawa).





The highest median age of employed residents was recorded in Podkowa Leśna (48 years) Another measure characterising persons employed in the national economy is the mean age. In Mazowieckie Voivodship it was the same as in the country and at the end of 2022 it amounted to 42.4 years. In m.st. Warszawa, the mean age was lower than in the Voivodship and amounted to 41.7 years. The highest mean age of employed persons was recorded in the urban gmina of Podkowa Leśna – 47.8 years, and the lowest in the rural gmina of Mirów – 40.1 years. Among employed men, the mean age was higher than that of women (42.6 compared to 42.2 years), however, in 63 gminas of the Voivodship the mean age of employed women was higher.

Among persons employed in the national economy, we can distinguish pensioners, disabled persons and foreigners. At the end of December 2022, pensioners from Mazowieckie Voivodship constituted 15.9% of all pensioners in the country, disabled persons – 9.2%, and foreigners – 23.4%. The majority of employed pensioners and persons with disabilities were women (54.2% and 51.3%, respectively), and among foreigners – men (60.9%).
