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**GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT  
IN MAZOWIECKIE VOIVODSHIP IN THE YEARS 2010–2012**

When publishing Statistical Office data please indicate the source.

Data presented in the publication for the first time were compiled according to the principles of the “**European System of Accounts (ESA 2010)**”. Owing to the fact data for 2010 and 2011 have been changed in comparison to previously published data. Data by kind of activity were compiled according to the Polish Classification of Activities – PKD 2007 introduced on 1 I 2008 by the decree of the Council of Ministers dated 24 XII 2007 (Journal of Laws No. 251, item 1885), with later amendments. According to adopted classification abbreviations of some names of sections were applied – indicated by symbol „Δ”.

Data on voivodship and subregions were compiled according to the Nomenclature of Territorial Units for Statistical Purposes (NTS) as of 1 I 2013. (Decree of the Council of Ministers dated 14 XI 2007, Journal of Laws No. 214, item 1573, with later amendments).

Gross domestic product per capita was calculated on the basis of the number of population (as of 30 VI) based on the results of the Population and Housing Census 2011.

Valuable data and dynamics presented in the tables and in the analytical part – if not indicated otherwise – were compiled at current prices. Current prices from the year preceding the reference year were adopted as constant prices in the calculations of gross domestic product volume indices.

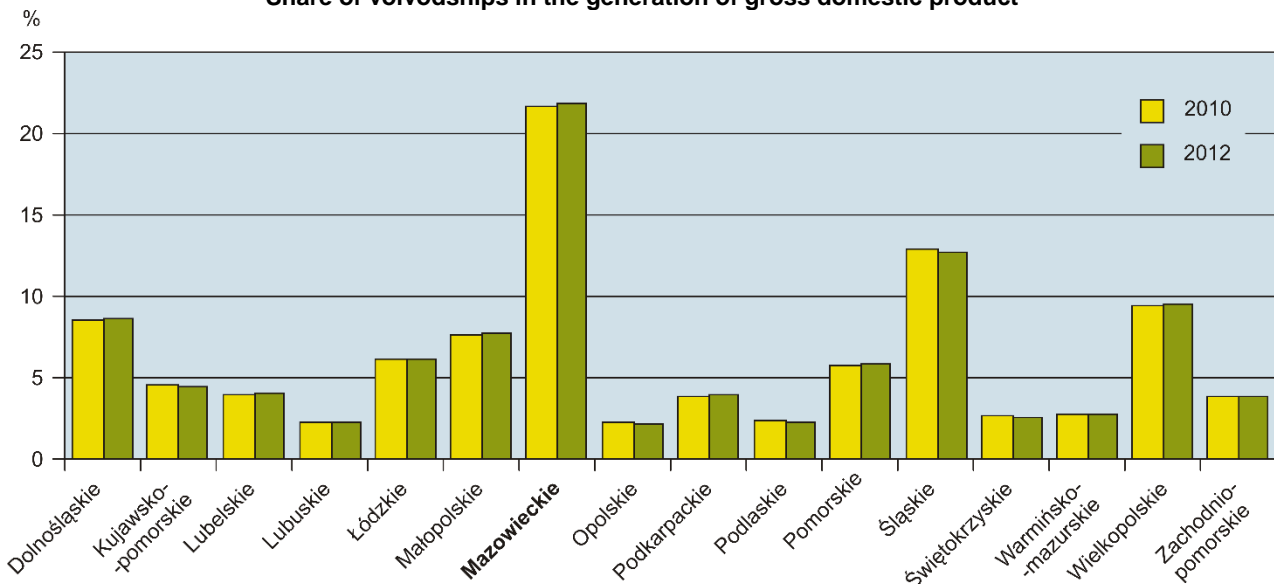
Relative numbers (indices, percentages) were calculated on the basis of absolute data expressed with higher precision than that presented in the text and tables. Due to rounding of data, there is a possibility of some discrepancies in the addition of data for total items in the tables. The numbers are content-wise correct.

Methodological explanations of basic terms and methods of data compilation one can find in the publication „Gross domestic product – Regional accounts in 2012”, Katowice 2014.

**GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT**

Mazowieckie voivodship is, economically, the strongest region of the country that produces the largest part of gross domestic product (GDP) illustrating a final result of activity of all entities of national economy. In 2012 share of Mazowieckie voivodship in generating GDP amounted to 21.9% and was by 0.2% percentage point higher than in 2010 and 2011.

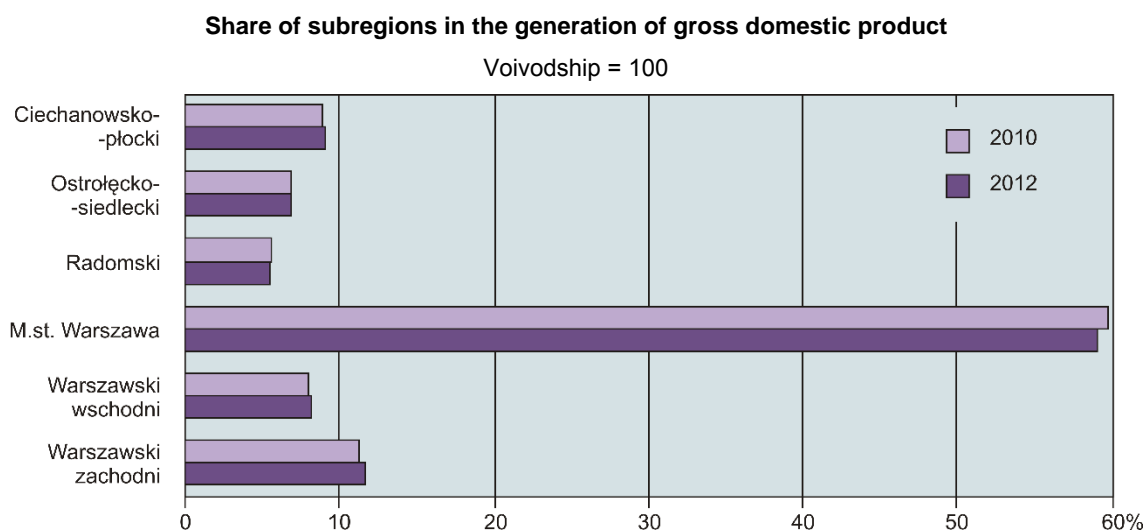
**Share of voivodships in the generation of gross domestic product**



Value of GDP produced in the voivodship in 2012 was as high as 353348 million zł and in comparison with a previous year it was – at current prices – higher by 5.0%, and at constant prices – by 2.2%. In comparison with the level from 2010, gross domestic product was in real terms higher by 6.8% (by 6.7% in the country); higher growth was recorded in five voivodships (7.1% in Lubelskie voivodship to 8.5% in Pomorskie and Wielkopolskie voivodships). In the years 2010 and 2012 average annual rate of growth of gross domestic product stood at 3.3% (at constant prices), i.e. the same as the national average. In comparison with other voivodships in terms of year-on-year growth of GDP volume, Mazowieckie voivodship was ranked six (ex aequo with Łódzkie voivodship).

Calculations' results of gross domestic product in territorial cross-section for the years 2010-2012 show a clear disparity in the level of economic growth in subregions of Mazowieckie voivodship. In 2012 share of individual subregions in generating GDP of the voivodship were as high as 5.4% in radomski subregion to 59.1% in m.st. Warszawa subregion; in 2010, it was 5.5% to 59.8% respectively. The gap between the subregions with the biggest and the smallest share in generating GDP decreased by 0.6 percentage point in the period under discussion (from 54.3 to 53.7 percentage points). However, the relation between these subregions remained unchanged – in 2010 as well as 2 years later the value of GDP produced in m.st. Warszawa subregion was 11 times higher than in radomski subregion.

In comparison to 2010 three subregions increased their share in producing gross domestic product, of these warszawski zachodni increased the most (by 0.4 percentage point), two subregions reduced their share, including the share of m.st. Warszawa – by 0.7 percentage point, but the share of ostrołęcko-siedlecki subregion did not change.

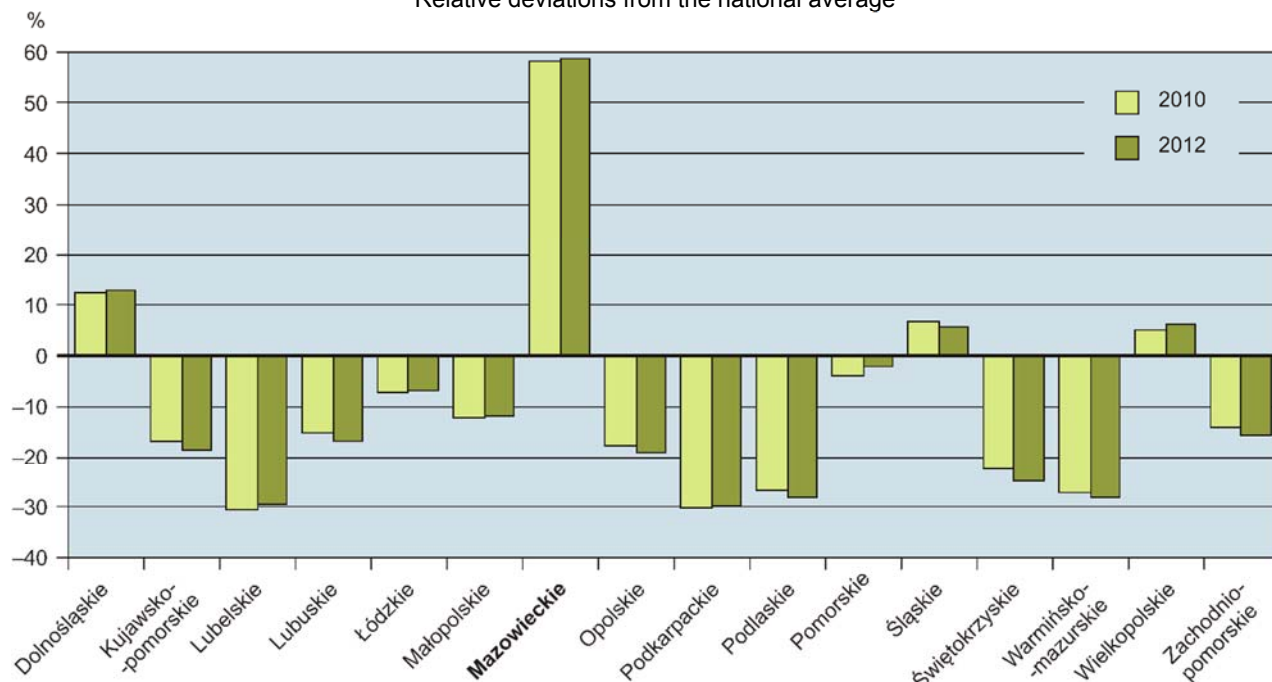


#### GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT PER CAPITA

Territorial differences in the level of economic development best illustrate gross domestic product per capita. In 2012 the average level of this rate for Mazowieckie voivodship was 6675 zł and was higher by 4.7% in comparison with the previous year. In real terms it was higher by 1.8% compared to 2011, and compared to 2010 – by 6.0% (in the country by 1.7% and 6.5% respectively). Mazowieckie voivodship reached the highest level of this rate in Poland – in 2012 it was higher by 59.2% (by 24821 zł) than the national average; in 2011 it was higher by 58.2%, and in 2010 – by 58.7%.

### Gross domestic product per capita by voivodships

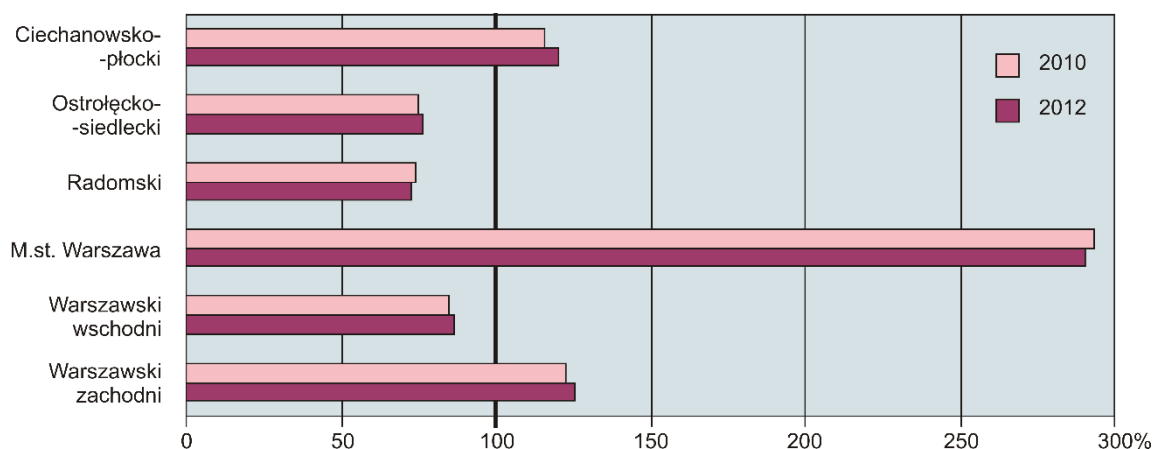
Relative deviations from the national average



Value of GDP per capita varies greatly among individual subregions of the voivodship – in 2012 this rate amounted to 30375 zł in radomski subregion to 122005 zł in m.st. Warszawa. M.st. Warszawa holds first position in terms of level of GDP per capita exceeding the national average by 190.9%. In the remaining subregions of the voivodship GDP per capita amounted to 72.4% of the national average (in radomski subregion) to 125.5% (in warszawski zachodni). The lowest value of GDP per capita recorded in 2012 in radomski subregion constituted 24.9% of the level of this rate generated in m.st. Warszawa subregion. In 2010 the ratio between the subregion with the lowest rate (radomski as well) and subregion with the highest rate (m.st. Warszawa) stood at 25.1%.

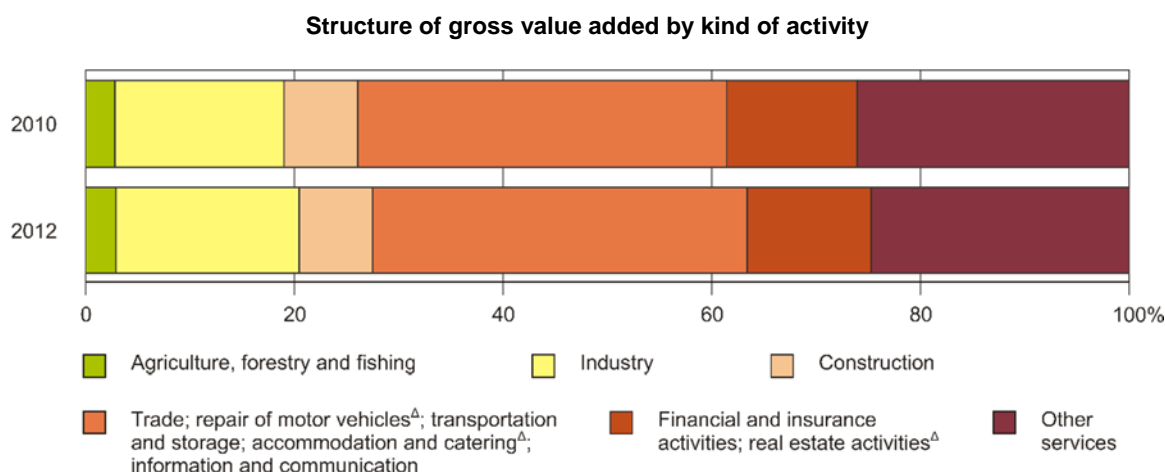
### Gross domestic product per capita by subregions

## GROSS VALUE ADDED

Gross value added (GVA) measures the newly generated value as a result of the production activity of national institutional units. In the years 2010-2012 in Mazowieckie voivodship, similarly as in the country, the highest gross value added generated entities conducting activity in trade; repair of motor vehicles; transportation and storage; accommodation and catering; information and communication, and the lowest share – entities conducting activity in agriculture, forestry and fishing.



In 2012 entities conducting activity in trade; repair of motor vehicles; transportation and storage; accommodation and catering; information and communication generated 36.0% of the voivodship gross value added, i.e. by 1.7 percentage points more than in 2011 and by 0.6 percentage point compared to 2010. Share of entities engaged in other services (including public administration and defence; compulsory social security) constituted 24.7% of GVA of the voivodship and it decreased compared with 2011 by 1.0 percentage point, and compared with 2010 by 1.3 percentage point. Industrial entities generated 17.6% of the voivodship gross value added, i.e. by 0.8 percentage point more than in 2011 and by 1.4 percentage point more than in 2010. Entities engaged in financial and insurance activities; real estate activities in 2012 generated 11.9% of the voivodship gross value added, i.e. by 0.9 percentage point less than in 2011 and by 0.6 percentage point than in 2010. Entities engaged in construction generated 7.1% of the voivodship GVA, i.e. by 0.3 percentage point less than in 2011 and the same as in 2010. Share of agriculture, forestry and fishing in generation of the voivodship gross value added in 2012 amounted to 2.8%; compared with 2011 decreased by 0.2 percentage point, and in comparison with 2010 increased by 0.1 percentage point.

The above presented changes in the structure of economy varied in individual subregions of the voivodship. Compared to 2010 the biggest changes were recorded in industry (ranging between plus 0.7 percentage point in m.st. Warszawa and plus 4.3 percentage point in ciechanowsko-płocki subregion). Slightly smaller changes took place in construction (minus 2.3 percentage point in warszawski zachodni to plus 0.7 percentage point in m.st. Warszawa). Changes recorded in the remaining kinds of activities ranged between minus 2.2 and plus 2.2 percentage point. It is noteworthy that in all subregions increased the share of entities engaged in industry and trade; repair of motor vehicles; transportation and storage; accommodation and catering; information and communication. In all subregions as well, decreased the share of entities engaged in financial and insurance activities; real estate activities and other services.

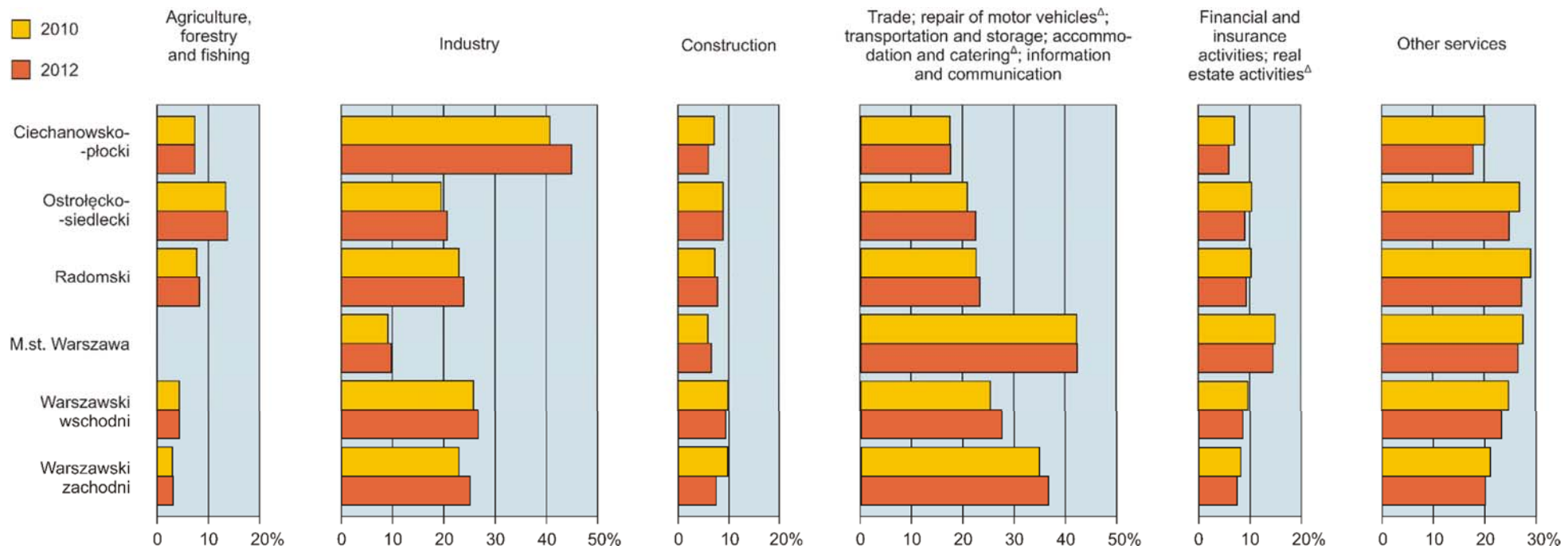
