

Gross domestic product in Mazowieckie voivodship in 2016





In 2016, the value of gross domestic product generated in Mazowieckie voivodship amounted to PLN 414,401 mln. In comparison with 2015, it was higher in current prices by 3.8%. GDP growth was recorded in all subregions except radomski.

Gross domestic product in current prices increased compared to 2015

The Mazowieckie voivodship is the economically strongest area of the country, in which the largest part of gross domestic product (GDP) is generated, as illustrated by the final result of the activities of all entities of the national economy. In 2016, the share of Mazowieckie voivodship in generating GDP amounted to 22.3% and was by 0.1 pp higher in relation to both 2015 and 2014.

In Mazowieckie voivodship, over 1/5 of the national GDP value was generated





The value of GDP generated in the voivodship in 2016 amounted to PLN 414,401 mln and, as compared to the previous year, was higher in current prices by 3.8% and in constant prices – by 4.2%. With reference to the level of 2014, the real gross domestic product was higher by 8.6% (in the country by 7.0%); higher increase was recorded only in Pomorskie Voivodship – by 9.9%. In the years 2014–2016, the average annual growth rate of gross domestic product stood at the level of 4.2% (in constant prices), with the national average of 3.4%. In comparison with other voivodships, this was one of the fastest increases in the volume of GDP on a year-to-year basis (the second place after Pomorskie voivodship with the average annual growth rate at the level of 4.8%).

The results of calculations of gross domestic product in the territorial cross-section for the years 2014–2016 indicate clear disproportions in the level of economic development of regions and subregions forming the macroregion of Mazowieckie voivodship¹. In Warszawski



stołeczny region, 17.0% of the national GDP was generated, while in Mazowiecki regionalny – 5.2%. In 2016, the shares of individual subregions in the generation of the macroregion's GDP ranged from 2.7% (żyrardowski subregion) to 59.9% (the subregion city of Warszawa); in 2014, from 2.7% to 60.3%. The difference between subregions with the largest and the lowest share in generating GDP decreased in the discussed period by 0.4 pp (from 57.6 to 57.2 pp). The relation between these subregions has hardly changed – both in 2014 and two years later, the value of GDP generated in the subregion city of Warszawa was about 22–23 times higher than in żyrardowski subregion.

In comparison with 2014, two subregions increased their share in generating gross domestic product, namely, płocki (by 0.7 pp) and warszawski zachodni (by 0.3 pp). The shares of the five subregions decreased, of which the most the city of Warszawa (by 0.4 pp), while the shares of two subregions – warszawski wschodni and żyrardowski - remained unchanged.


Figure 2. Share of subregions in generating gross domestic product (macroregion=100; current prices)

The territorial diversification of the level of economic development is best illustrated by the gross domestic product per capita. In 2016, the average level of this measure for Mazowieckie voivodship amounted to PLN 77,359 and was higher by 3.5% as compared to the previous year. In real terms, it was higher in 2015 by 3.9%, and in 2014 – by 8.0% (in Poland, by 3.1% and 7.1% respectively). Mazowieckie voivodship has the highest level of this indicator in Poland – in 2016 it exceeded the national average by 59.7% (by PLN 2,927); while in 2015 it was higher by 59.6%, and in 2014 – by 60.4%.


Figure 3. Gross domestic product per capita by voivodships (relative deviations from the national average in %; current prices)



The ratio of GDP per capita to the national average was 159.7%

In the macroregion Mazowieckie voivodship, the value of GDP per capita is clearly differentiated in individual subregions – in 2016, this rate ranged from PLN 32,830 in the case of radomski subregion, and to PLN 14,141 in the case of the city of Warszawa. In terms of GDP per capita, the city of Warszawa occupies the first place in Poland, outpacing the national average by 193.1%. In the remaining subregions of the voivodship, the recorded value of GDP per capita spread between 67.8% of the national average (radomski) and 157.9% (płocki). The lowest level of GDP per capita recorded in 2016 in radomski subregion accounted for 23.1% of the level of this measure obtained in the subregion city of Warszawa. In 2014, the relation of the subregion with the lowest rate (radomski) to the subregion with the highest rate (the city of Warszawa) was 23.5%. In the analyzed period there was a decrease by 1.1 pp of dispersion rate² of GDP per capita calculated at the level of subregions; in 2016 it amounted to 54.5%, while in 2014 – 55.6%.

² The dispersion rate (measure of variation) of regional GDP per capita was calculated at the level of subregions as the sum of absolute values of differences between values for subregions and macroregional value of GDP per capita, weighted by the share of the population of individual subregions in the macroregion, expressed in percentage of macroregional GDP per capita.
