

## Gross domestic product in Mazowieckie Voivodship in 2017





In 2017, the value of gross domestic product generated in Mazowieckie Voivodship amounted to PLN 446 586 million. In comparison with 2016, it was higher in current prices by 7.8%. GDP growth was recorded in all subregions.

Gross domestic product in current prices increased compared to 2016

The Mazowieckie Voivodship is the economically strongest area of the country, in which the largest part of gross domestic product (GDP) is generated, as illustrated by the final result of the activities of all entities of the national economy. In 2017, the share of Mazowieckie Voivodship in generating GDP amounted to 22.4% and was by 0.1 pp higher in relation to 2016 and by 0.2 pp higher than in 2015.

In Mazowieckie Voivodship, over 1/5 of the national GDP value was generated





The value of GDP generated in the voivodship in 2017 amounted to PLN 446 586 million and, as compared to the previous year, was higher in current prices by 7.8% and in constant prices – by 5.6%. With reference to the level of 2015, the real gross domestic product was higher by 10.0%. It was the highest GDP growth in the country, 1.8 pp higher than the average. In the years 2015–2017, the average annual growth rate of gross domestic product stood at the level of 4.9% (in constant prices), with the national average of 4.0%. Compared toother voivodships, this was one of the fastest increases in the volume of GDP on a year-to-year basis (Małopolskie Voivodship was ranked second with an average annual growth rate at the level of 4.6%).


The results of calculations of gross domestic product in the territorial cross-section for the years 2015–2017 indicate clear disproportions in the level of economic development of regions and subregions forming województwo mazowieckie macroregion<sup>1</sup>. In warszawski



stołeczny region, 17.2% of the national GDP was generated, while in mazowiecki regionalny – 5.2%. In 2017, the shares of individual subregions in the generation of the macroregion's GDP ranged from 2.6% (żyrardowski subregion) to 60.5% (Warszawa subregion); in 2015, from 2.8% to 59.6%. The difference between subregions with the largest and the lowest share in generating GDP increased in the discussed period by 0.1 pp (from 56.8 to 57.9 pp). The relation between these subregions deteriorated – while in 2015 the value of GDP generated in Warszawa subregion was 22 times higher than in żyrardowski subregion, two years later it was 23 times higher.

In comparison with 2015, two subregions increased their share in generating gross domestic product – Warszawa (by 0.9 pp) and ciechnowski (by 0.1 pp). The shares of six subregions decreased, of which the most warszawski zachodni (by 0.3 pp), while the share of one subregion – ostrołęcki – remained unchanged.






The territorial diversification of the level of economic development is best illustrated by the gross domestic product per capita. In 2017, the average level of this measure for Mazowieckie Voivodship amounted to PLN 83.123 and was higher by 7.4% as compared to the previous year. In real terms, it was higher compared to 2016 by 5.3%, and to 2015 – by 9.4% (in Poland, by 5.0% and 8.3% respectively). Mazowieckie Voivodship has the highest level of this indicator in Poland – in 2017 it exceeded the national average by 60.5% (by PLN 31.347); while in 2016 it was higher by 59.7%, and in 2015 – by 59.6%.


The ratio of GDP per capita to the national average was 160.5%

In the macroregion Mazowieckie Voivodship, the value of GDP per capita is clearly differentiated in individual subregions – in 2017, this rate ranged from PLN 35.670 in radomski subregion, and to PLN 153.550 in Warszawa. In terms of GDP per capita, the city of Warszawa occupies the first place in Poland, outpacing the national average by 196.6% (in 2015 by 191.9%). In the remaining subregions of the voivodship, the recorded value of GDP per capita spread between 68.9% of the national average (in radomski) and 149.9% (in płocki). The lowest level of GDP per capita recorded in 2017 in radomski subregion accounted for 23.2% of the level of this measure obtained in the subregion of Warszawa. In 2015, the relation of the subregion with the lowest rate (radomski) to the subregion with the highest rate (Warszawa) was 24.0%. In the analyzed period there was an increase by 1.5 pp of dispersion rate² of GDP per capita calculated at the level of subregions; in 2017 it amounted to 55.5%, while in 2015 – 54.0%.





The level of GDP per capita above the national average was obtained in 3 subregions

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> The dispersion rate (measure of variation) of regional GDP per capita was calculated at the level of subregions as the sum of absolute values of differences between values for subregions and macroregional value of GDP per capita, weighted by the share of the population of individual subregions in the macroregion, expressed in percentage of macroregional GDP per capita.


