


Gross domestic product in Mazowieckie Voivodship in 2018




In 2018, the value of gross domestic product generated in Mazowieckie Voivodship amounted to PLN 477 857 million. In comparison with 2017, it was higher in current prices by 7.2%. GDP growth was recorded in all subregions.

Mazowieckie Voivodship is the economically strongest area of the country, in which the largest part of gross domestic product (GDP) is generated, as illustrated by the final result of the activities of all entities of the national economy. In 2018, the share of Mazowieckie Voivodship in generating GDP amounted to 22.5% and was by 0.1 pp higher in relation to 2017 and by 0.3 pp higher than in 2016.

In Mazowieckie Voivodship, over 1/5 of the national GDP value was generated

Chart 1. Share of voivodships in generating gross domestic product (Poland=100; current prices)




The value of GDP generated in the voivodship in 2018 amounted to PLN 477 857 million and, as compared to the previous year, was higher in current prices by 7.2% and in constant prices – by 6.4%. With reference to the level of 2016, the real gross domestic product was higher by 12.4%. It was one of the highest GDP growth in the country, 1.9 pp higher than the average. In the years 2016–2018, the average annual growth rate of gross domestic product stood at the level of 6.0% (in constant prices), with the national average of 5.1%. Compared to other voivodships, this was the fastest year-to-year increase in the volume of GDP (ex aequo with Małopolskie Voivodship).


The results of calculations of gross domestic product in the territorial cross-section for the years 2016–2018 indicate clear disproportions in the level of economic development of regions and subregions forming województwo mazowieckie macroregion¹. In warszawski

stołeczny region, 17.3% of the national GDP was generated, while in mazowiecki regionalny – 5.2%. In 2018, the shares of individual subregions in the generation of the macroregion's GDP ranged from 2.5% (żyrardowski subregion) to 60.5% (Warszawa subregion); in 2016, from 2.7% to 59.7%. The difference between subregions with the largest and the lowest share in generating GDP increased in the discussed period by 0.1 pp (from 57.0 to 58.0 pp). The relation between these subregions deteriorated – while in 2016, the value of GDP generated in Warszawa subregion was 22 times higher than in żyrardowski subregion, two years later it was 24 times higher.

In comparison with 2016, only one subregion increased their share in generating gross domestic product – Warszawa (by 0.8 pp). The shares of five subregions decreased, of which the most of płocki (by 0.4 pp), while the shares of three subregions remained unchanged.






The territorial diversification of the level of economic development is best illustrated by the gross domestic product per capita. In 2018, the average level of this measure for Mazowieckie Voivodship amounted to PLN 88 626 and was higher by 6.9% as compared to the previous year. In real terms, it was higher compared to 2017 by 6.0%, and to 2016 – by 11.6% (in Poland, by 5.4% and 10.5% respectively). Mazowieckie Voivodship has the highest level of this indicator in Poland – in 2018, it exceeded the national average by 60.5% (by PLN 33 396); while in 2017, it was higher by 60.2%, and in 2016 – by 59.2%.


The ratio of GDP per capita to the national average was 160.5%

In województwo mazowieckie macroregion, the value of GDP per capita is clearly differentiated in individual subregions – in 2018, this rate ranged from PLN 37 484 in radomski subregion, and to PLN 163 372 in Warszawa. In terms of GDP per capita, Warszawa occupies the first place in Poland, outpacing the national average by 195.8% (in 2016, by 191.1%). In the remaining subregions of the voivodship, the recorded value of GDP per capita spread between 67.9% of the national average (in radomski) and 150.9% (in płocki). The lowest level of GDP per capita recorded in 2018 in radomski subregion, accounted for 22.9% of the level of this measure obtained in the subregion of Warszawa. In 2016, the relation of the subregion with the lowest rate (radomski) to the subregion with the highest rate (Warszawa) was 23.4%. In the analyzed period, there was an increase by 1.3 pp of dispersion rate² of GDP per capita calculated at the level of subregions; in 2018, it amounted to 55.4%, while in 2016 – 54.1%.





The level of GDP per capita above the national average was obtained in 3 subregions

² The dispersion rate (measure of variation) of regional GDP per capita was calculated at the level of subregions as the sum of absolute values of differences between values for subregions and macroregional value of GDP per capita, weighted by the share of the population of individual subregions in the macroregion, expressed in percentage of macroregional GDP per capita.




