



Geographical location of Warsaw





Structure of built-up and urbanized areas in 2020





Area of parks, lawns and green areas of housing estates per capita and monuments of nature in 2020








Structure of population by economic age groups



Population density^a in 2020







Internal migration of population for permanent residence by age groups in 2020



Net migration^a for permanent residence in 2020







Structure of post-primary school graduates from the school year 2019/20







Structure of students^a of higher education institutions by fields of education in 2020



Graduates of higher education institutions^a in 2020 by selected fields of education in % of total graduates of given sex















Registered unemployed persons^a per 1,000 population of working age in 2020









Main causes of road traffic accidents in 2020















Bed places and occupancy rate in selected accommodation facilities in 2020




Hotels^a by category in 2020






Average length of stay of tourists in tourist accommodation establishments in 2020




Tourists accommodated in 2020



Foreign tourists accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments in 2020














Entities of the national economy in 2020


Structure of entities of the national economy^a by legal status in 2020


Entities of the national economy per 1 km² in 2020




Structure of entities of the national economy by sections in 2020










Revenue of the district part of Warsaw capital city budget per capita in 2020




Revenue and expenditure of Warsaw capital city








