



#### **Geographical location of Warsaw**







#### Geodesic area of m.st. Warszawa by directions of land use in 2021










#### Structure of population by economic age groups



#### Population density<sup>a</sup> in 2021





# Internal migration of population<sup>a</sup> for permanent residence by age groups in 2021



#### Natural increase of population in 2021




#### Net migration<sup>a</sup> for permanent residence in 2021







#### Structure of students<sup>a</sup> of higher education institutions by fields of education in 2020



#### Graduates of higher education institutions<sup>a</sup> by selected fields of education in % of total graduates of given sex in 2021











#### Statistical unemployed resident of Warsaw<sup>a</sup> in 2021




# Registered unemployed persons<sup>a</sup> per 1,000 population of working age in 2021











#### Main causes of road traffic accidents in 2021






### Subscribers per 1,000 population in 2021





### Bed places and occupancy rate in selected accommodation facilities in 2021




#### Hotels<sup>a</sup>by category in 2021






### Average length of stay of tourists in tourist accommodation establishments in 2021














#### Entities of the national economy in 2021

### Structure of entities of the national economy by legal status in 2021




### Entities of the national economy per 1 ${\rm km^2}$ in 2021




#### Structure of entities of the national economy by sections in 2021







# Revenue of the district part of the budget of m.st. Warszawa per capita in 2021




### Revenue and expenditure of Warsaw capital city budget by selected divisions in 2020







#### M.ST. WARSZAWA COMPARED TO VOIVODSHIP CITIES IN 2021



Due to the nature of the publication, explanations, detailed comments and notes on methodology published in other publications of the Statistical Office in Warszawa, were omitted in the publication.

Data on the population and demographic indicators, as well as calculations per capita (1,000 population) were prepared on the basis of the results of the National Population and Housing Census 2021, therefore the values for 2020 have been changed compared to those previously published.

Due to the electronic mode of data processing, in some cases sums of components may differ from the amount given in the "total" item. Some information for the last year was given on the basis of preliminary data and may change in subsequent publications.
