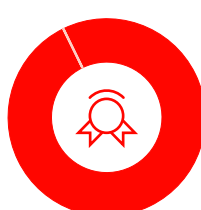

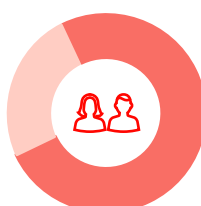

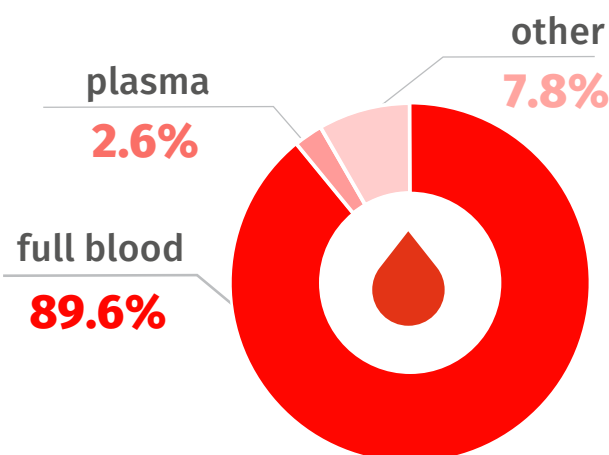

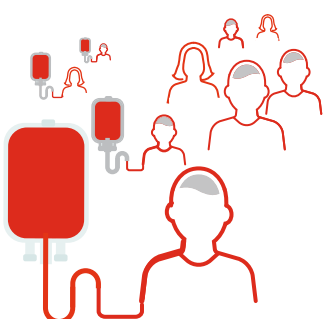

NUMBER OF DONATIONS^a PER 10 THOUSAND POPULATION IN 2023

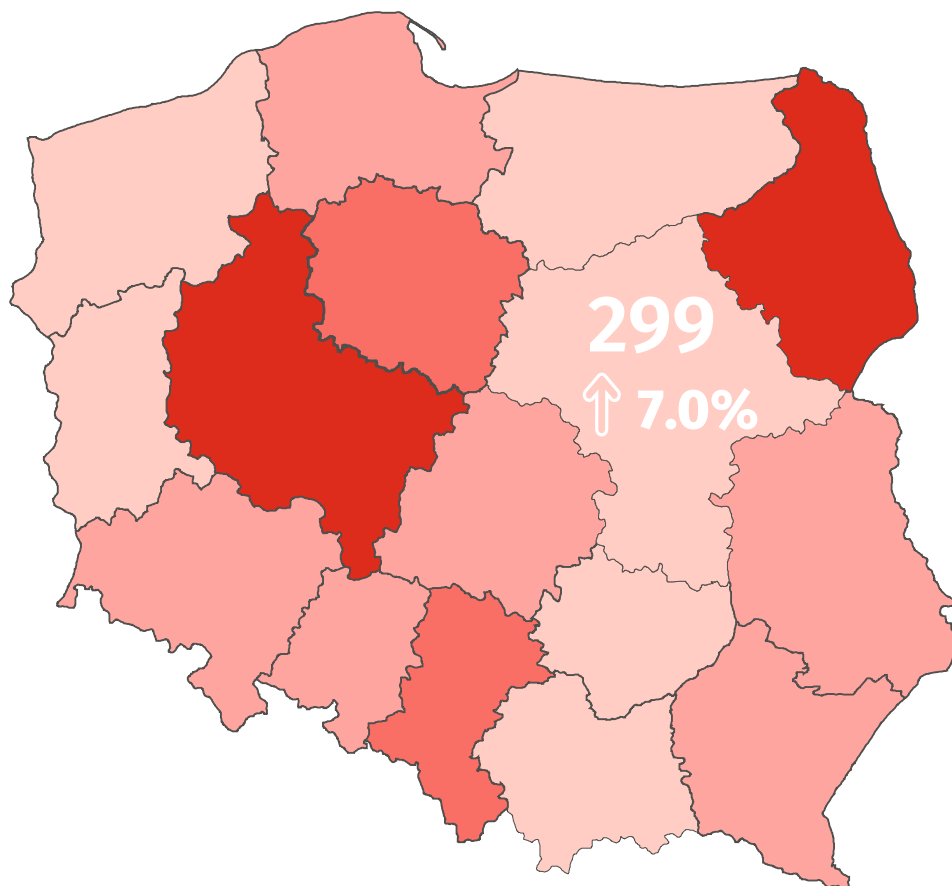

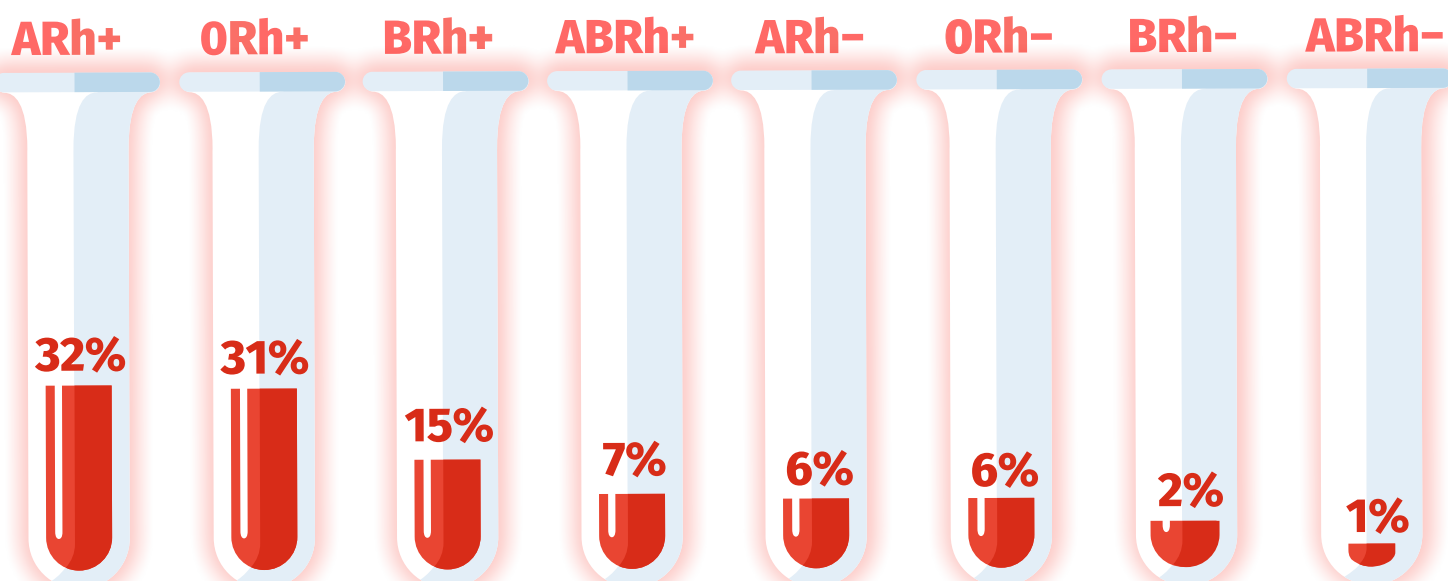
