

since the introduction of the three-level territorial division of the country into voivodships, powiats and gminas.


Local government elections were held on 24 April 2024 for the 9th time since the introduction of the Act on Local Government in 1990 and for the 6th time since the introduction of the three-level territorial division of the country.

A total of 5,779 councillors were elected from among 22,615 of candidates for the voivodship regional council, powiat, cities with powiat status and gminas councils.

ELECTION TURNOUT FOR THE COUNCILS OF GMINAS AND CITIES WITH POWIAT STATUS



On 7 April, 314 village mayors, mayors and presidents of cities were elected from among 874 candidates,

including in 48 gminas and cities where only 1 candidate was registered.

They were chosen by 57.04% of persons eligible to vote.

On 21 April, the second round of elections was held in 100 gminas.


STATISTICAL PORTRAIT OF A VILLAGE MAYOR, MAYOR AND PRESIDENT OF A CITY


