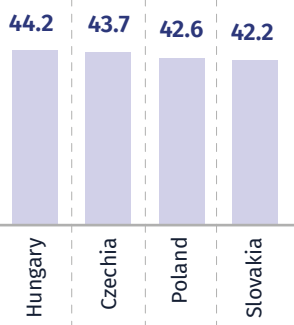

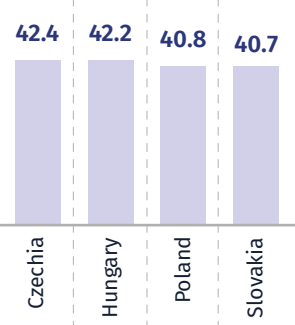

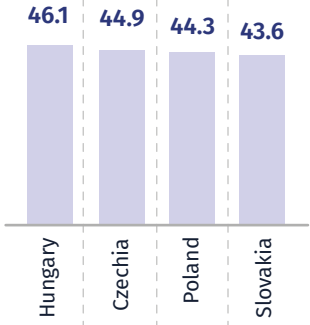

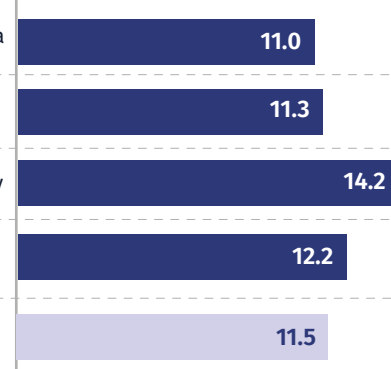

Births per 1 000 population



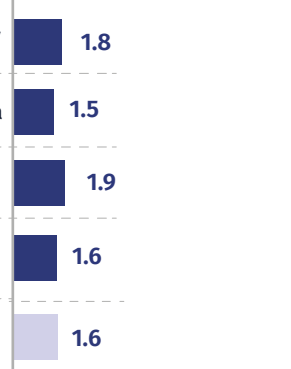

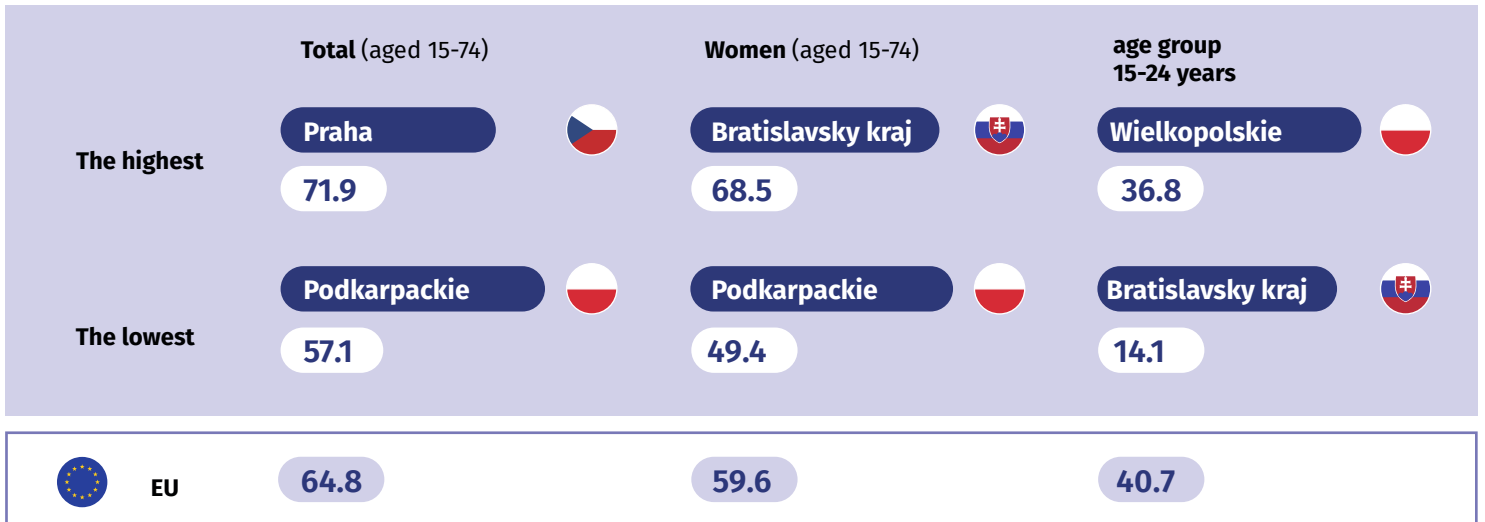

Economic activity rate* by regions of the Visegrad Group (NUTS 2)



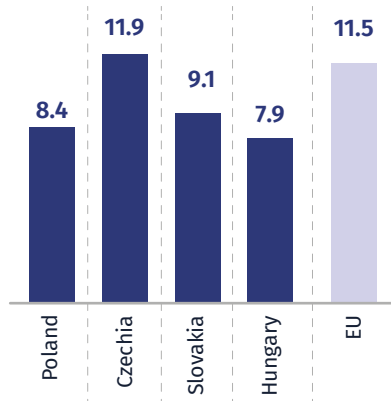

Responsible consumption and production

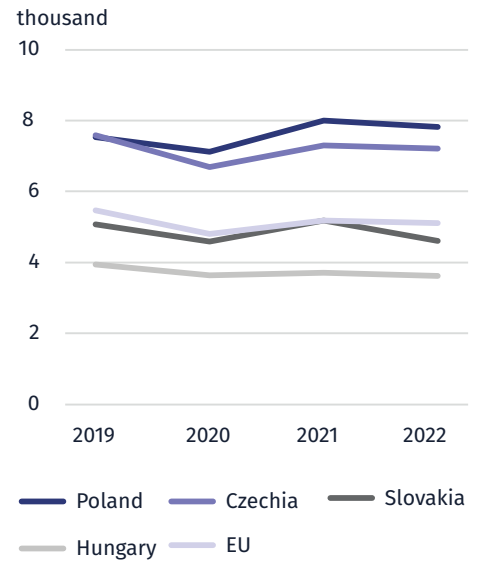
One of the main issues covered by cooperation within V4 is transition to the **CIRCULAR ECONOMY**. This is also a priority for the European Union.

A circular economy, by extending the life of a product, in practice means reducing waste to a minimum.

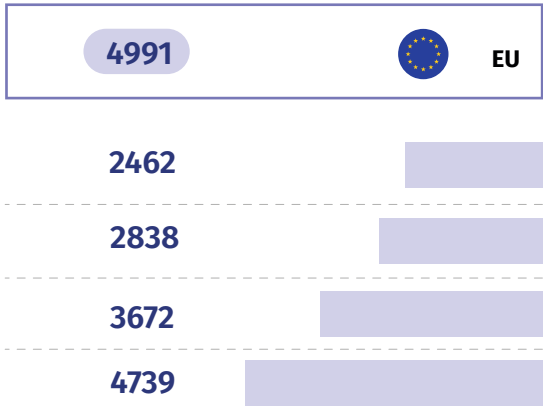
Circular material use rate



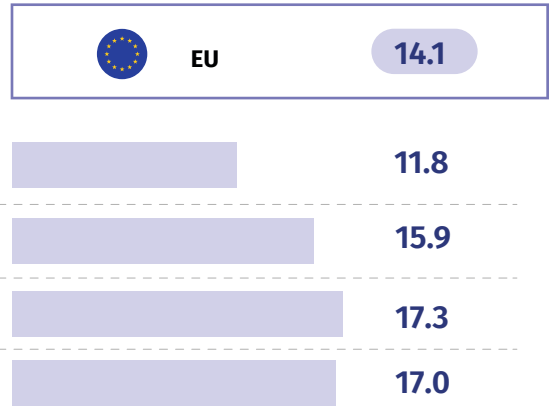
Air emissions – carbon dioxide



Generation of waste (kg/capita)



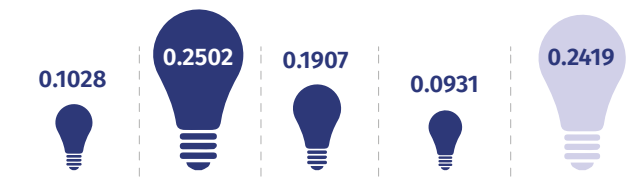
Raw material consumption (tonnes/capita)



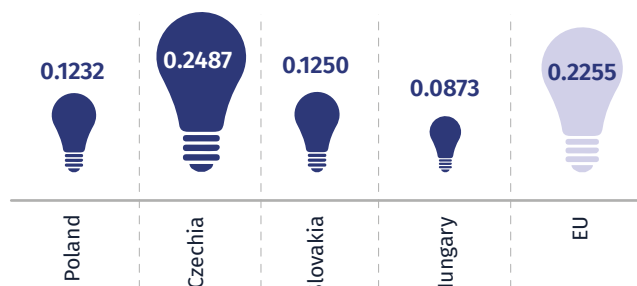
Electricity prices for household consumers (euro/kWh)

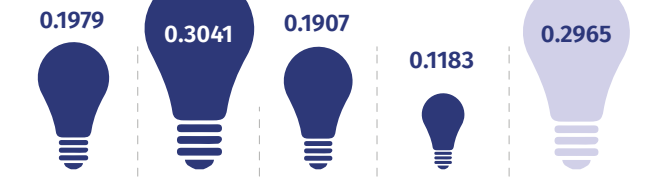


Second half of the year
