REGON



Register (REGON) is continuously updated collection of information on the entities of the national economy in a computer system in the form of the central database and the field databases . It was established on the basis of Article 41 paragraph 1 Point 1 of Act of 29 June 1995 on public statistics (OJ U. of 2012, item 591, as amended)

Entries in a register REGON shall be done by the following:

- legal persons,
- organizational units without legal personality,
- natural persons conducting economic activity (including those running individual farms),
- local units of above mentioned entities.

Each entity is given a unique identification number REGON. In accordance with Article 42 paragraph 6 of the Act on public statistics an entity is obliged to submit a relevant application within 14 days from the occurrence of the circumstances justifying the entry, change or deletion from the register (REGON).
